TIME EXPRESSIONS

Time expressions are words or phrases that indicate when something happens or how long it lasts. They help us place events in time and understand their sequence.

IN

It is used for long or definite periods such as months, years or parts of the day.

ON

Used for specific days

DEMONSTRATIVES

The demonstratives one and ones are used in English to avoid repetition of a previously mentioned noun.

ONE

One is used to talk about something that has already been identified

ONES

Is used when we substitute names in the plural

PREFERENCES: COMPARISONS WITH ADJECTIVES

Comparisons with adjectives are used to contrast two or more people, objects, or ideas regarding a specific quality.

ADJECTIVES ONE OR TWO SYLLABLE

used to compare two items, indicating that one has more, less, or the same

ADJECTIVES THREE OR MORE SYLLABLE

It is used to indicate that a thing or person has the highest or lowest degree of a characteristic

UNTIL
Specify a time limit for doing an action or for an event to take place
