EXAMPLE

I VISIT MY FAMILY IN EVERY YEAR I GO TO THE SCHOOL ON WEEKENDS I LOVE SWIN PURING SUMMER I VE LIVE IN PICHUCALCO FOR 5 YEARS I ARRIVED AT THE CLASS LATE AGAIN

DEMOSTRATIVES

Demonstratives are words used to indicate the distance of a person or thing from the speaker or writer. They can also be used to show the psychological or physical closeness or distance.

ONES

A plural pronoun

ONE A singular pronoun that is gender-neutral and means "a person". It is a thirdperson singular pronoun for verb agreement, but it can sometimes be used with first- or second-person reference.

EXAMPLE

WHICH IS YOUR CAR, THE RED ONE OR THE BLUE ONE? THIS GLASS IS DIRTY, CAN I HAVE A CLEAN ONE PLS? I LIKE THOSE SHOES, THE RED ONES I DON'T LIKE THESE BOOTS, THE SILVER ONES MY GLASSES ARE BROKEN, I NEED SOME NEW

PREFERENCE-COMPARISONS WITH ADJECTIVES



Comparative adjectives are used to compare two things or people, and to express preferences and differences



THREE OR MORE SYLLABLE
