# English Grammar

## The Verb "Be"

- Use of the present (am/is/are)
  - Examples
    - \* I am a student
    - \* She is my friend
    - \* They are happy
- Question formation
  - structure: Verb + subject
  - Examples: Are you ready?
- Negations
  - Use of not
  - Example: He is not here

**Conjugations**

I am	You are	He is
We are	You are	They are
It is	She is	It is

## Possessive Adjectives

Adjectives that indicate Possession

Example

- my - his
- your - her
- his - their

**Possessive adjectives**

**Possessive nouns**

This is my house	This is my son	This is his office
John's house	Paul's son	The teacher's office
Her house	His son	His office

## Articles a, an

- Use of "a"
  - used before words that begin with a consonant sound
  - Example: a dog, a car
- Use of "an"
  - used before words that begin with a vowel sound
  - Example: an apple, an hour

## This/these It/they

**This** (Singular) For example: like this apple

**These** (Plural) For example: like these apples

**It** used to refer to an object or thing in singular

**They** used to refer to things or people in plural

**That** (Singular) For example: like that apple

**Those** (Plural) For example: like those apples

## Prepositions of place

Words that indicate the location of something

Examples

- in - on
- at - under
- next to - between

**Relationships of place**

IN FRONT OF	ON	UNDER
IN	ON	UNDER
BEHIND	UNDER	NEAR
BEHIND	UNDER	NEAR
BEHIND	UNDER	NEAR
BEHIND	UNDER	NEAR
