Pronouns	Be	contraction

They	are	They're
he	is	He's
she	is	She's
it	is	it's.

They are used to show who something belongs to, they are words that are placed before a noun and help indicate possession or relationship

Article a, an

Are used in English as an indefinite article and serve to refer to a noun in a general, non specific way

"A" is used before a word that begins with a consonant sound, "An" is used before words that begin with a sound vocal

Example

I saw a cat



Use of "This and These / it and They

The "This" is used to refer to an object, animal or idea in the singular, it has no gender and is used when the noun has already been mentioned or when something specific is not being talked about, the "these" is used to refer to a group of people, objects or animals in plural

Example

Estos son mis Amigos
These are my friends



Prepositions of place

Prepositions of place are words that indicate the location of something or the direction in which it is moving.

Example

The dog is in the garden
