The Verb "be"

The verb be is used to express identity, characteristics, states, location and also as an auxiliary in the formation of other verb tenses.

Example

I am a student



Possessive Adjectives

Possessive Adjectives are used to show ownership or relationships. They modify nouns and indicate who something belongs to.

Example

My book is on the table.



Article a, an

Article a and an are used before singular nouns. A is used before words starting with a consonant sound, and an before words starting with a vowel sound.

Example

He has a car. She is an engineer.



Use of This and That/It and They

"This" and These are demonstratives used to indicate objects close to the speaker. It and they are pronouns. It refers to a singular thing, while they refers to plural things.

Example

I like this dress. I love these flowers. It is raining today.



Prepositions of Place

Prepositions of place are words that indicate the location of something or someone, or the direction in which it is moving. In a sentence, they function as connectors that show the relationship between a word and the object of the preposition.

Example

The cat is in the box.
