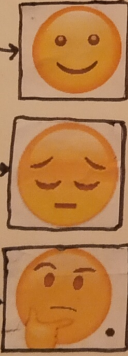

 what's her name? Her name is Jennifer.

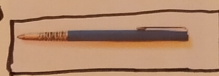
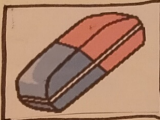

 What's **her** name? Her name is Jennifer.

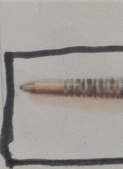
