The Verb "Be"

The verb "be" is one of the few verbs that changes depending on the pronoun: (I am, you are, he is, she is, they are)

Example

I am a police



Possessive Adjectives

It is a word or grammatical construction that indicates a relationship of belonging, in a broad sense

Example

My name is box bunny



Article a, an

The articles "a" and "an" are used before singular nouns. "A" is used before words starting with a consonant.

Example

I have a dog



Use of this and these / it and they

"This" and "these" are demonstratives used to indicate objects. "It" and "they" are pronouns referring to a singular thing.

Example

This is my car.



Prepositions of place

A preposition of place is a preposition which is used to refer to a place or space. "in", "on", "under", "next to"

Example

The TV is on the table.
