Article a, an...

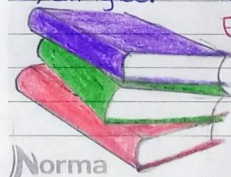
Indefinite articles "a" and "an" are used before a noun to indicate that they noun a specific one.

A

Use "a" before words that start with a consonant sound. Examples: a book, a car, a dog.

AN

Use "an" before words that start with a vowel sound. Examples: an apple, an elephant, an igbo.

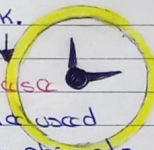


This and These

This

This is used when referring to the object or person to be pointed out. This also indicates that this object or person is near us.

Example: This is a clock.



These

These are used when the objects and people we want to point out are plural. We also use these to indicate that this object or people are nearby and are plural.

Example: These are a clocks.

Prepositions of place

A preposition of place is a word that helps us identify position and location in sentences. It describes where something is in relation to another object. Prepositions of place are short words, and they usually come before a noun or pronoun.
