 The top stripe is saffron (orange), symbolizing bravery and sacrifice. • The middle stripe is white, representing peace and truth. • The bottom stripe is green, symbolizing fertility and prosperity. In the center of the white stripe is a 24spoke wheel, called "Ashoka Chakra", representing the law of dharma (justice and morality).


