The South Korean flag, also known as Taegeukgi, was created on January 27, 1948. **Principal Dishes** 

1. Kimchi (Kimchi) - Fermented vegetable dish

- 2. Bibimbap (Bibimbap) Mixed rice bowl
  - 3. Bulgogi (Bulgogi) Marinated beef
- 4. Japchae (Japchae) Stir-fried glass noodles

5. Naengmyeon (Naengmyeon) - Cold buckwheat noodle
