Creation of the South Korean Flag

The South Korean flag, also known as Taegeukgi, was created on January 27, 1948.

Principal Dishes

1. Kimchi (Kimchi) - Fermented vegetable dish
2. Bibimbap (Bibimbap) - Mixed rice bowl
3. Bulgogi (Bulgogi) - Marinated beef
4. Japchae (Japchae) - Stir-fried glass noodles
5. Naengmyeon (Naengmyeon) - Cold buckwheat noodle



The design of the flag was inspired by the Korean independence movement and the country's rich cultural heritage. The flag features a white background with a red and blue taegeuk symbol in the center, surrounded by four black trigrams.
