The National Museum of Fine Arts, It has the largest collection of Argentine Art in the country.

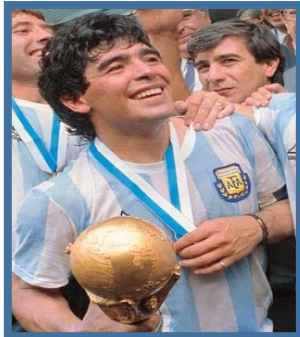


The Colón Theater is an opera house, It has come to be considered one of the best lyrical theaters in the world.

The pericón is a folklore dance in Argentina. This dance consists of a set of loose and interdependent couples.



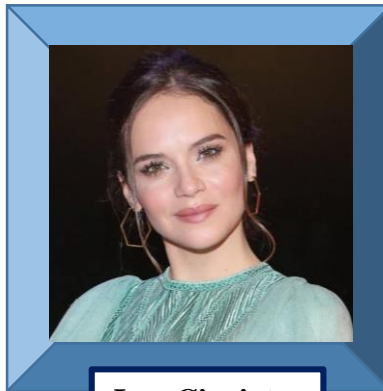
The when is a musical style and a native folk dance originating from the Andean and central provinces of Argentina.

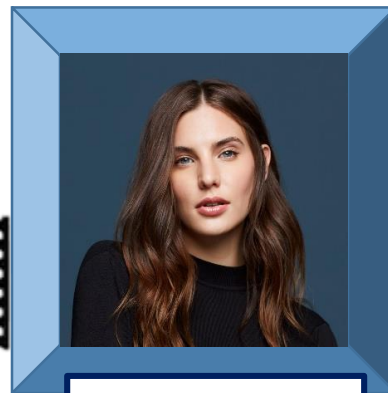
