Tourist places:

Traditions:

Sirtaki: It has its roots in traditional Turkish dances. It is a group dance that starts slowly and increases speed.

Turkish Weddings: Weddings are usually large celebrations that can last several days, with rituals that include traditional music and dance.

Ramadan: During this sacred month, Muslims do not eat from dawn to sunset. At the end of every day, families meet to break the tradition with special meals.



Traditional meals:

Dolma: This dish consists of grape leaves stuffed with rice, meat and spices.

Borek: It is a pie made with filo dough and can be filled with cheese, spinach or meat.

Pide: Turkish pizza, Pide is an elongated flatbread topped with minced meat, vegetables or cheese and then baked until crispy.
