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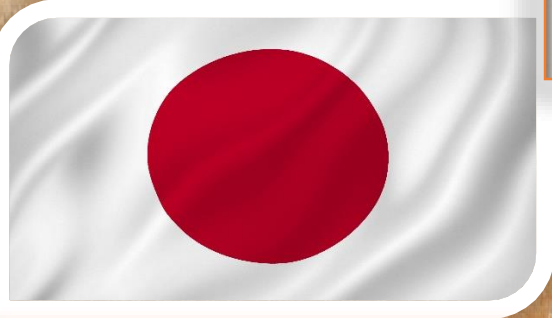

Japanese traditional dances are a rich cultural expression that reflects the country's history, religion, and customs. Among the most notable are **Noh**, with its solemnity and spiritual symbolism; **Kabuki**, known for its energetic and theatrical style; and **Bon Odori**, a popular dance celebrated during the Obon festival to honor the spirits of ancestors. There is also **Awa Odori**, a joyful, community-based dance from the Shikoku region, and **Buyo**, which encompasses classical dances combining elegance and precision. Each of these dances has its own roots and meanings, but all share the purpose of conveying emotions and keeping Japan's cultural traditions alive.
