### CHARACTERISTICS OF THE SYMPTOMS

It is caused by a virus that spreads through the air or by contact.

### medicines to prevent rubella

The best way to protect against rubella is with the MMR vaccine.

### ORIGIN OF RUBELLA

It was first described in the mid-15th century by 2 German doctors, but in 1941 Gregg, an Australian ophthalmologist, established a relationship and an epidemic of Rubella in women at the beginning of pregnancy.

### CHARACTERISTICS OF THE SYMPTOMS.

\*nasal discharge.  
\*cough.  
\*Watery eyes and redness.  
\*Small white spots on the inner side of the cheek.

### CHARACTERISTICS OF THE DISEASES

It can cause severe health problems, including severe diarrhea, ear infection, blindness, pneumonia, and encephalitis.

### Where did the measles disease originate?

The first description is attributed to the Hebrew doctor AlIyehudi in the 7th century and to the Persian doctor, who lived in the 10th century and called it, eruption.

### treatment for measles

There is no specific treatment for measles, most patients recover in 2 or 3 weeks.

### microorganisms that cause measles

It belongs to the paramyxoviridae family and the morbillivirus genus. It is a virus with single-stranded RNA

### measles medicine

with the triple viral vaccine or MMR

### characteristics of the symptoms

pain in abdomen, neck, muscles, pelvis or testicles. Chills, fever, malaise or loss of appetite. Dry mouth, inflammation of salivary glands and difficulty swallowing.

### characteristics of the diseases.

contagious disease caused by painful inflammation of the salivary glands.

### Where did mumps originate?

It originated in the year 640 BC. The doctor Tasos approximately in the year 410 BC, and provided the most complete description of the disease.

### treatment for mumps

There is no specific treatment, just apply hot or cold compresses to the neck area.

### mumps microorganisms

infectious disease caused by the paramyxovirus virus that is transmitted through saliva droplets.

### medicines for mumps

take pain relievers such as ibuprofen and paracetamol to relieve pain
