
1. A: These cotton gloves are nice.

 A: They're also expensive. (expensive)




2. A: Those silk jackets look attractive

 B: Yes, but the wool ones are warmer. (warm)




3. A: This purple shirt is an interesting color!  
 B: Yes, but the color is prettier the design. (pretty)




A: The design isn't bad.
