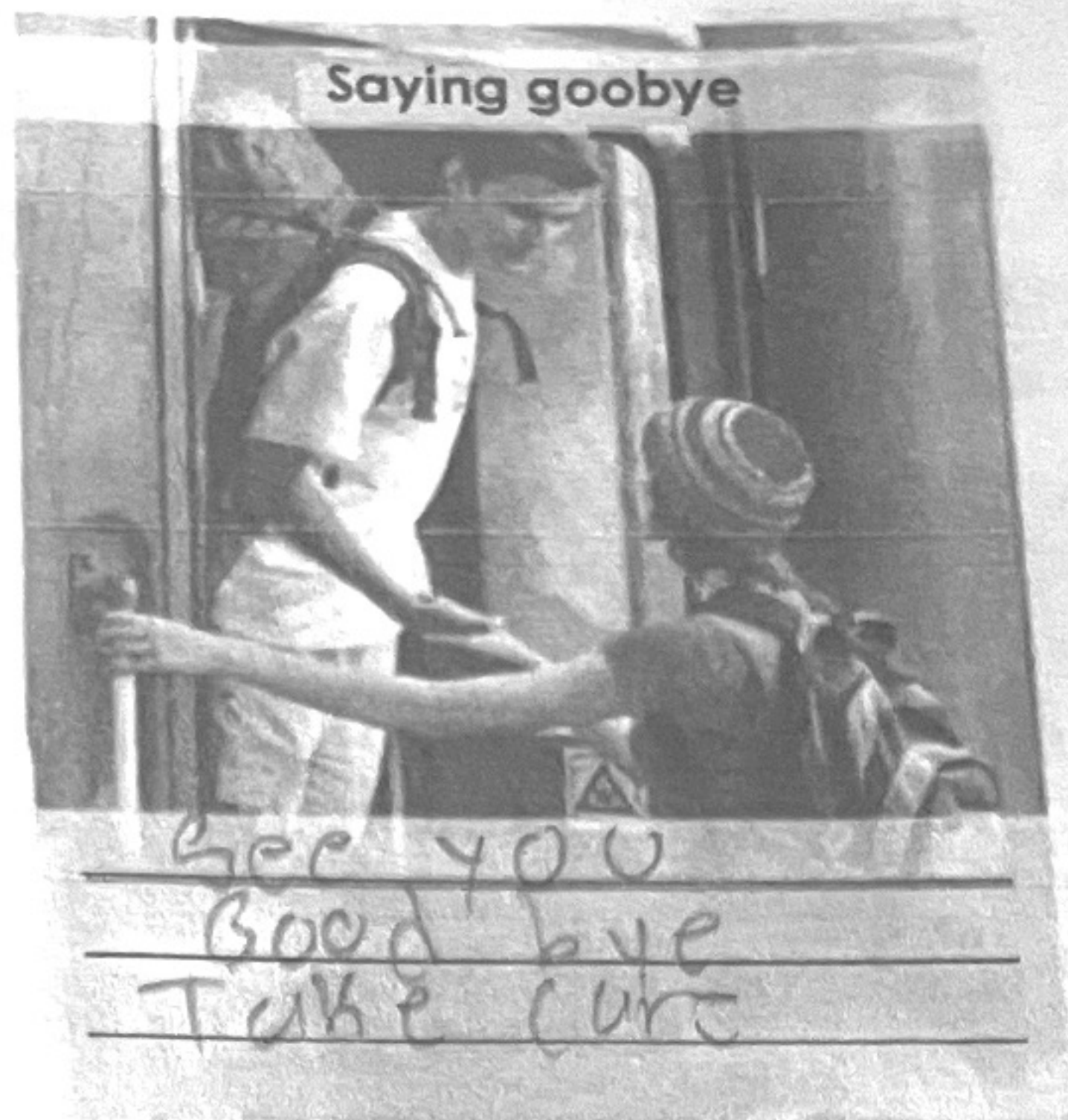
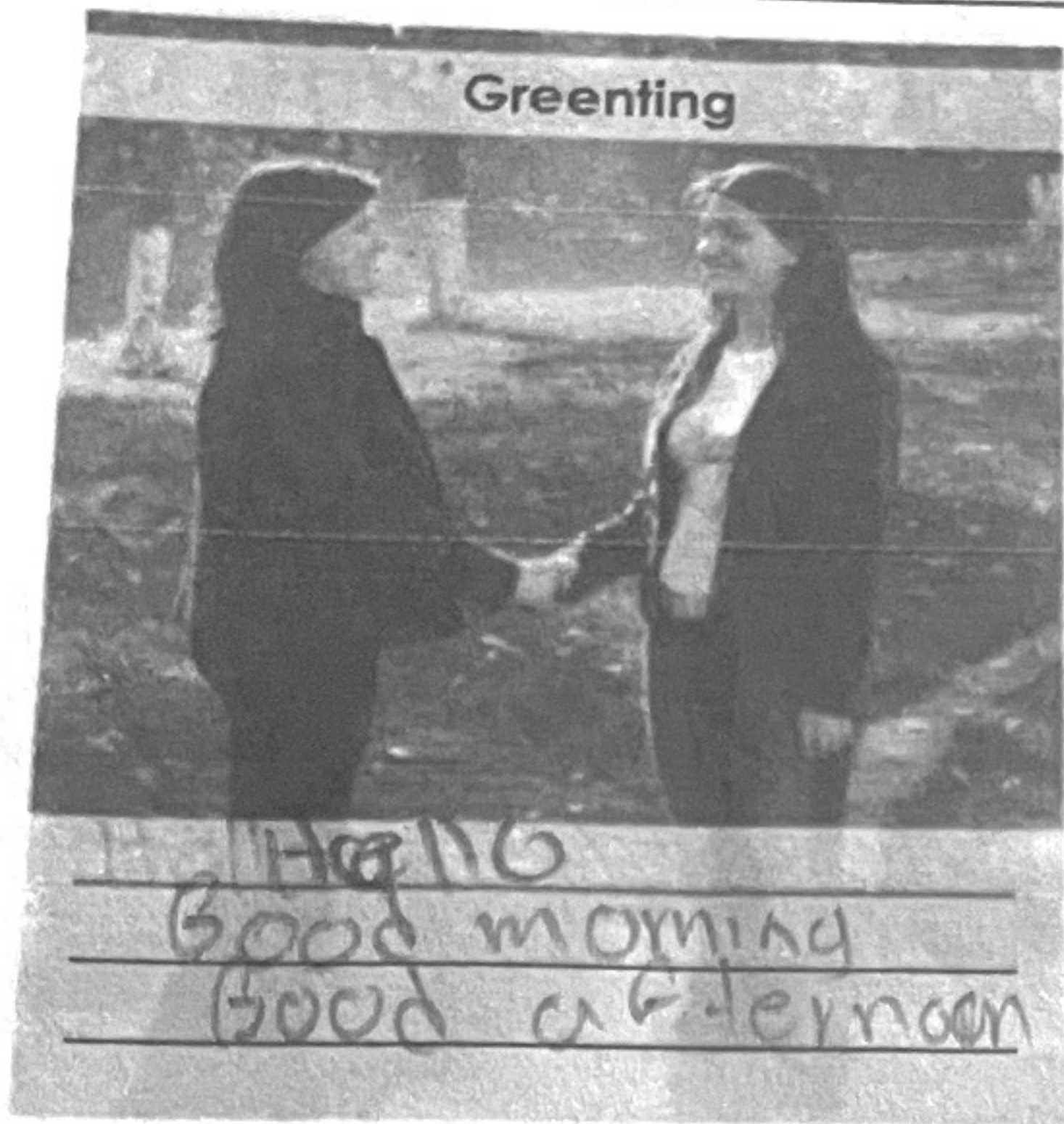

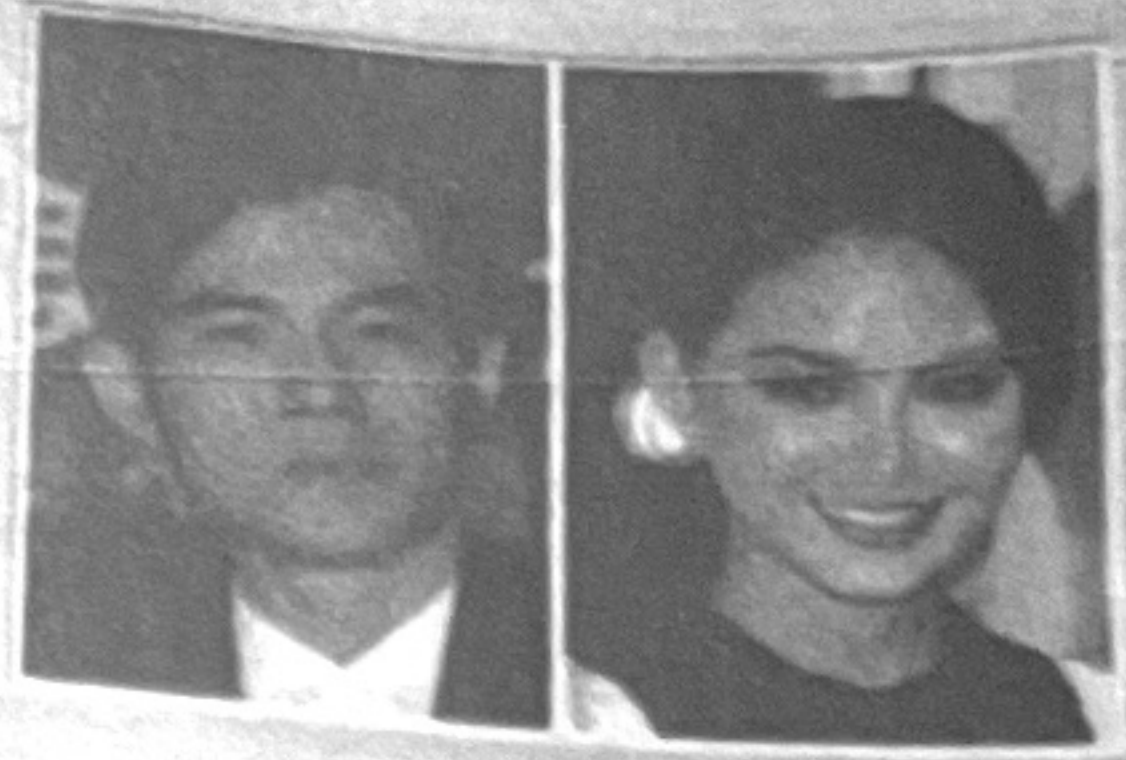
# Who Are They?

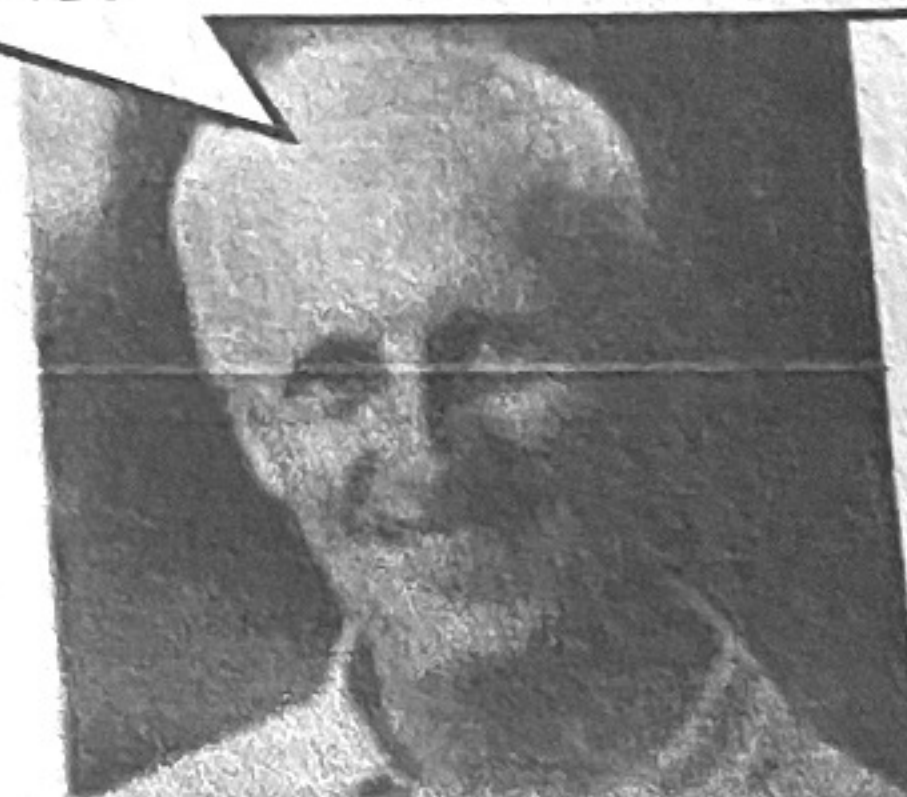
