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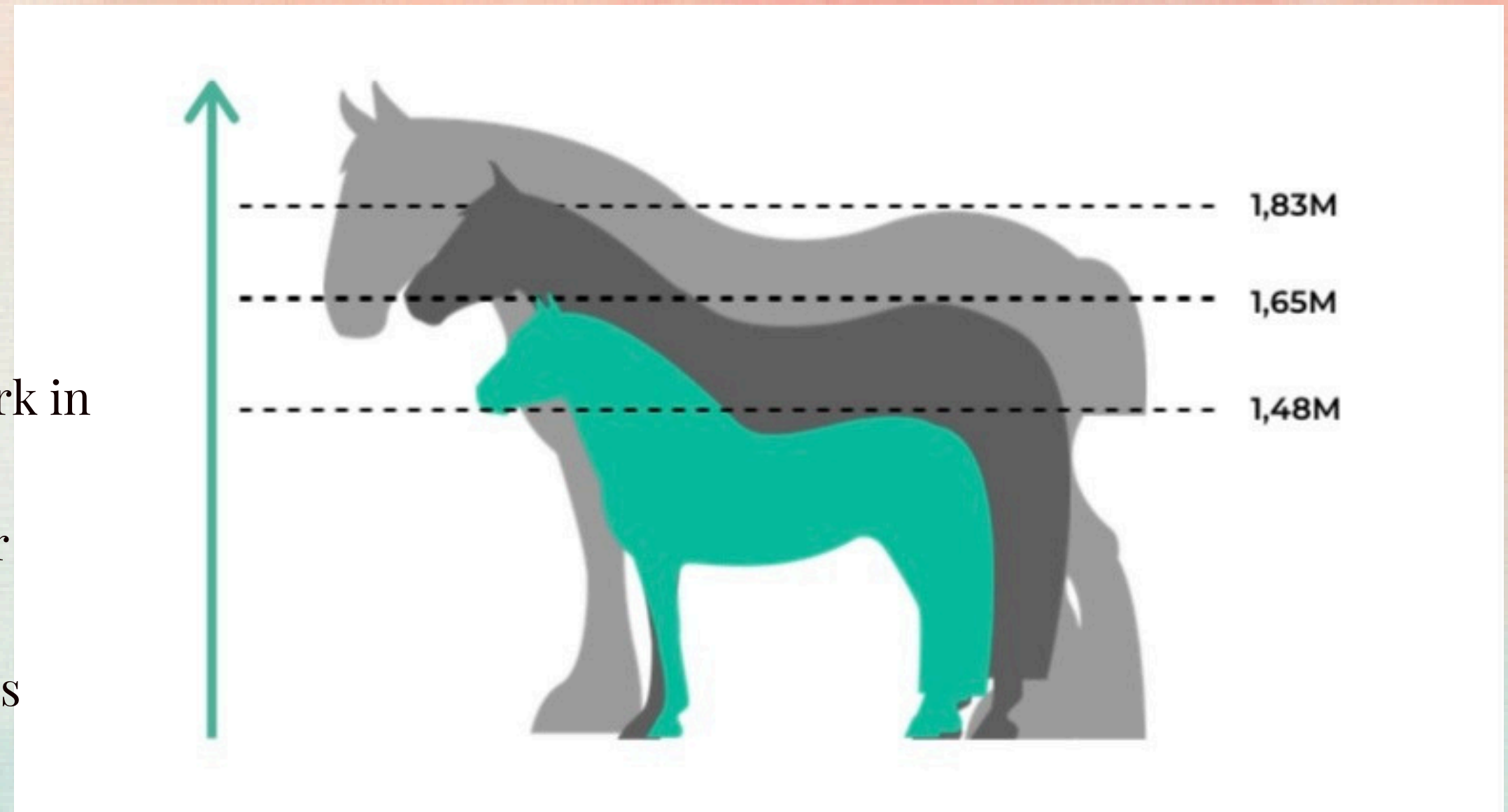


DID YOU KNOW THAT HORSES ARE PART OF THE EQUINE FAMILY?

Horses are herbivorous animals known for their strength, agility, and special bond with humans throughout history.

Within horses we can find three different types:

- DRAFT HORSES: strong and taller, ideal for work in the field and pulling carts.
- SADDLE HORSES: lighter and faster, perfect for riding long distances.
- PONIES: more robust in appearance than horses and can measure a maximum of 1.48m

HOW LONG DO HORSES LIVE?


The average lifespan of horses ranges between 25 and 40 years. Although they can live a few years longer in captivity, they can be ridden well into their 20s.

HORSE HABITAT

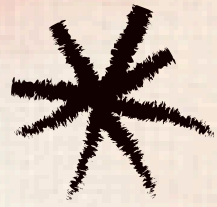
