# Negative form

I am not      I'm not

you are not    You aren't

he is not      He's not

she is not    she isn't

it is not      it isn't

we are not    we aren't

you are not.    You aren't

they are not.    They aren't

he.    Is he ?

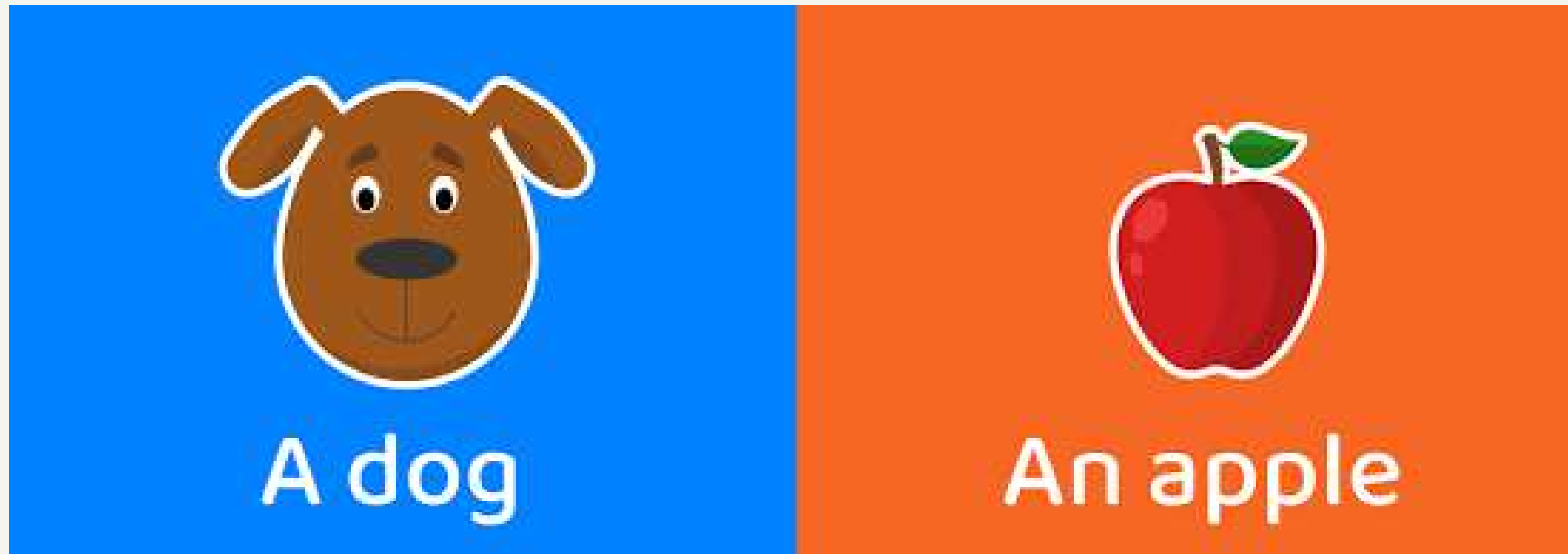
she    Is she?

An "a"

We use A with nouns that begin with a consonant sound. Example:  
Usamos A con los sustantivos que inician con sonido de consonante.

We use AN with nouns that begin with a vowel sound.  
Usamos AN con los sustantivos que inician con sonido de vocal.

## SUBJECT PRONOUN

I have a shirt.

You have a book.

YOU HE

SHE

He has a pillow.

She has a dog.

IT WE

It has a bone.

We have a bird.

YOU

You have a house.

THEY They have a car.

## POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE

My shirt is green.

MY

YOUR Your book is new.

HIS

His pillow is soft.

HER

Her dog is small.

ITS

Its bone is old.

OUR

Our bird is noisy.

YOUR Your house is big.

THEIR Their car is slow.
