Do you have any question / ¿tienen alguna pregunta?

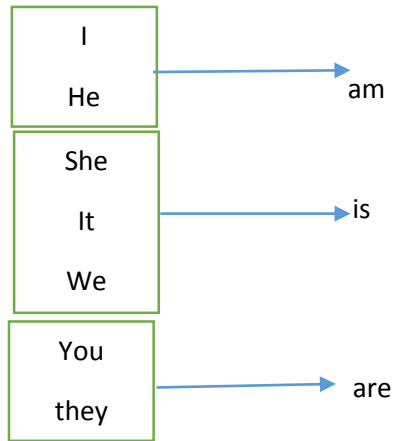
So far so good / ¿todo bien hasta ahora?

## Affirmative form



## Examples

Subject+verb+complement

1. I **am** Jesús Emilio
2. Guadalupe **is** my brother
3. you **are** chofer

## Negative form

I am **not**-----i'm **not**  
He is **not**-----he is**n't**  
She is **not**-----she is**n't**  
It is **not**-----it's **not**  
We are **not**-----we are**n't**  
You are **not**-----you are**n't**  
They are **not**-----they are**n't**

## Negative form

Subject+verb+not+complement

1. \_ i´m not jesus Emilio
2. \_ Guadalupe isn´t my brother
3. \_ you aren´t chofer

## Short answers

### Examples

1. \_ i am emilio?  
Yes, you are / no, you aren´t.
2. \_ are you a chofer?  
Yes. I am. / no, i´m not.
3. \_ is he my brother?  
Yes, he is. / no, he isn´t

#### Subject pronoun

<b>I</b>	/ I have a shirt.
<b>YOU</b>	/ You have a book.
<b>HE</b>	/ He has a pillow.
<b>SHE</b>	/ She has a dog.
<b>IT</b>	/ It has a bone.
<b>WE</b>	/ We have a bird.
<b>YOU</b>	/ You have a house.
<b>THEY</b>	/ They have a car.

#### possessive adjective

<b>MY</b>	/ My shirt is green.
<b>YOUR</b>	/ Your book is new.
<b>HIS</b>	/ His pillow is soft.
<b>HER</b>	/ Her dog is small.
<b>ITS</b>	/ Its bone is old.
<b>OUR</b>	/ Our bird is noisy.
<b>YOUR</b>	/ Your house is big.
<b>THEIR</b>	/ Their car is slow.

Articles a/an

We use **A** with nouns that **begin** with a **consonant sound**.

Usamos **A** con los sustantivos que inician con sonido consonante.

We use **AN** with nouns that begin with a vowel sound.

Usamos **AN** con los sustantivos que inician con sonido de vocal.

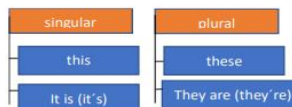

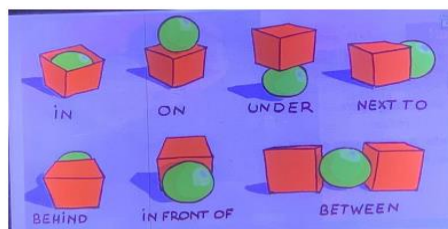
