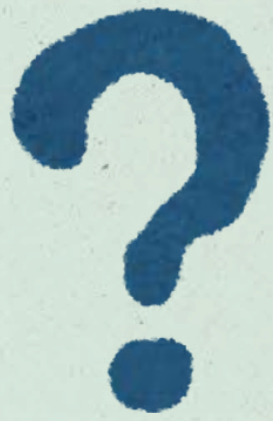

YOUR= POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE

-You need to bring dictionary.

YOU'RE= YOU ARE (CONTRACTION)

-You're an excellent student.

ITS= POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE

-The dog played with its ball.

IT'S= IT IS (CONTRACTION)

-It's very hot right now.

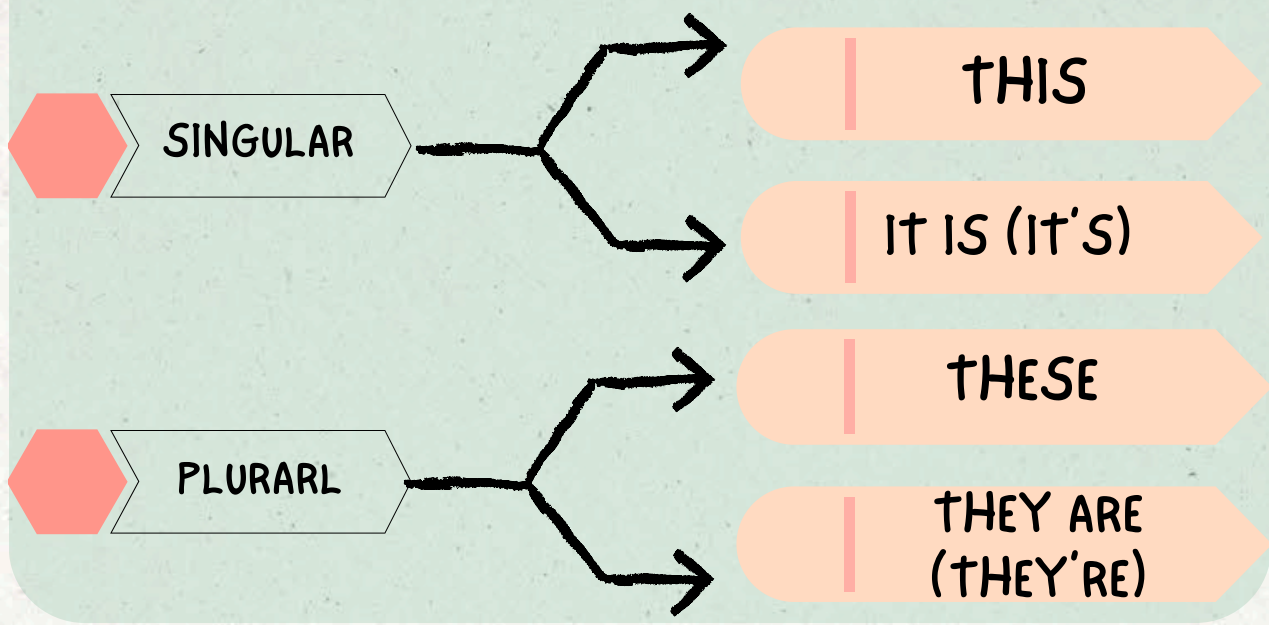
