Personal pronouns


They are the pronouns in charge of replacing the subject of the sentence, that is, the one who executes the action.

I, He, She, It, We, You, They



Affirmative form

The present simple sentences formed in this way are characterized by the simplicity of their structure



Examples
I am Santiago.
You are a Student.
He is my brother

Negative form

Negative sentences are sentences that deny information.

Subject + verb + not + complement

EXAMPLES
I'm not Katia.
You aren't a student.
We aren't the champions



Interrogative form

An interrogative sentence is a sentence used to request information and sometimes to express pragmatically softened commands or suggestions.



Verb + subject + complement /?



EXAMPLES
Am I Katia?
Are you a student?
Is she a nurse?
