PRESENTE SIMPLE	PRESENTE CONTINUO
+ AFIRMATIVA	+ AFIRMATIVA
I / you / we / they eat pizza. he / she / it eats pizza.	I am eating pizza. he / she / it is eating pizza. you / we / they are eating pizza.
- NEGATIVA	- NEGATIVA
I / you / we / they don't eat pizza. he / she / it doesn't eat pizza.	I am not eating pizza. he / she / it isn't eating pizza. you / we / they aren't eating pizza.
? INTERROGATIVA	? INTERROGATIVA
Do I / you / we / they eat pizza? Does he / she / it eat pizza?	Am I eating pizza? Is he / she / it eating pizza? Are you / we / they eating pizza?
= RESPUESTAS CORTAS	= RESPUESTAS CORTAS
= Yes, I do . No, I don't . = Yes, she does . No, she doesn't .	= Yes, I am . No, I am not . = Yes, she is . No, she isn't . = Yes, they are . No, they aren't .

Have got - short answers

- Have you got a dog?
 - Have you got a cat?
 - Has he got a bike?

- Yes, I have / No, I haven't
 - Yes, I have / No, I haven't
 - Yes, he has / No, he hasn't

Ortografía de los verbos regulares

bake+d
baked

Si el verbo termina en "e", solamente agregamos una "d".

carry i+ed
carried

Si el verbo termina en "consonante +y", cambiamos la "y" por una "i" y agregamos "ed".

stop+p+ed
stopped

Si el verbo es de una sílaba y tiene la forma "c+v+c", doblamos la última consonante y agregamos "ed".

commit+t+ed
committed

Si el verbo tiene dos sílabas y la segunda es estresada, doblamos la última consonante y agregamos "ed".

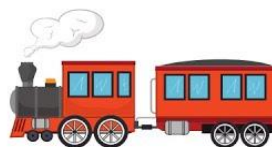
