Do	-O	+es	Does
Wish	-Sh	+es	Wishes
Watch	-Ch	+es	Watches
Wax	-X	+es	Waxes
Fly	Consonant+Y	+ies	Flies

## Spelling Rules

Most Verbs: add **s**

Verbs ending in: **s, ss, sh, ch, or x**, add **es**

If a verb ends in a **Consonant + Y** the **y** changes to **ies**

Verbs such as **have, do, and go** are irregular

- live → lives      enjoy → enjoys
- start → starts    rain → rains
- miss → misses    search → searches
- wash → washes    fix → fixes
- study → studies    try → tries
- carry → carries    fly → flies
- have → has      go → goes
- do → does
