AFIRMATIVE SUBJECT + TO BE + VERB + ING + COMPLEMENT

Example: I am playing tennis.



NEGATIVE SUBJECT + TO BE + NOT + VERB + ING + COMPLEMENT

Example: Eve is not writing a letter.




INTERROGATIVE TO BE + SUBJECT + VERB + ING + COMPLEMENT + ?

Example: Is he going to eat?



SHORT ANSWERS

PRONOUN VERB

 **YES, she is.**

PRONOUN VERB NOT

 **NO, she isn't.**

Example: Is Valeria dancing alone right now?
