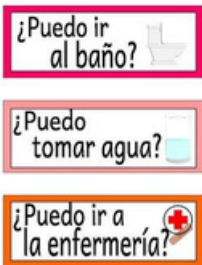

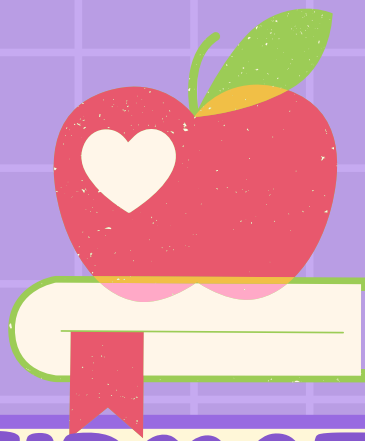
FORMAL GREETINGS

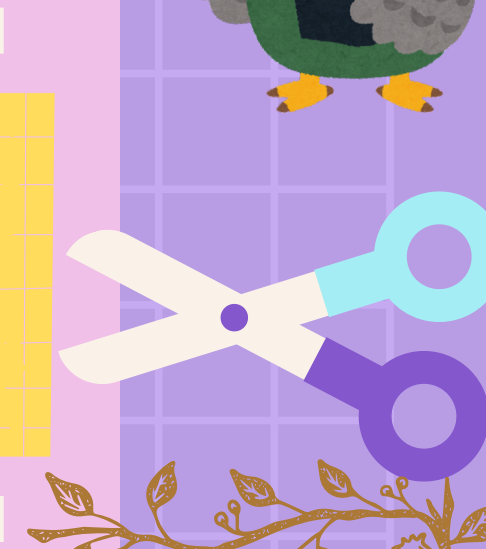
