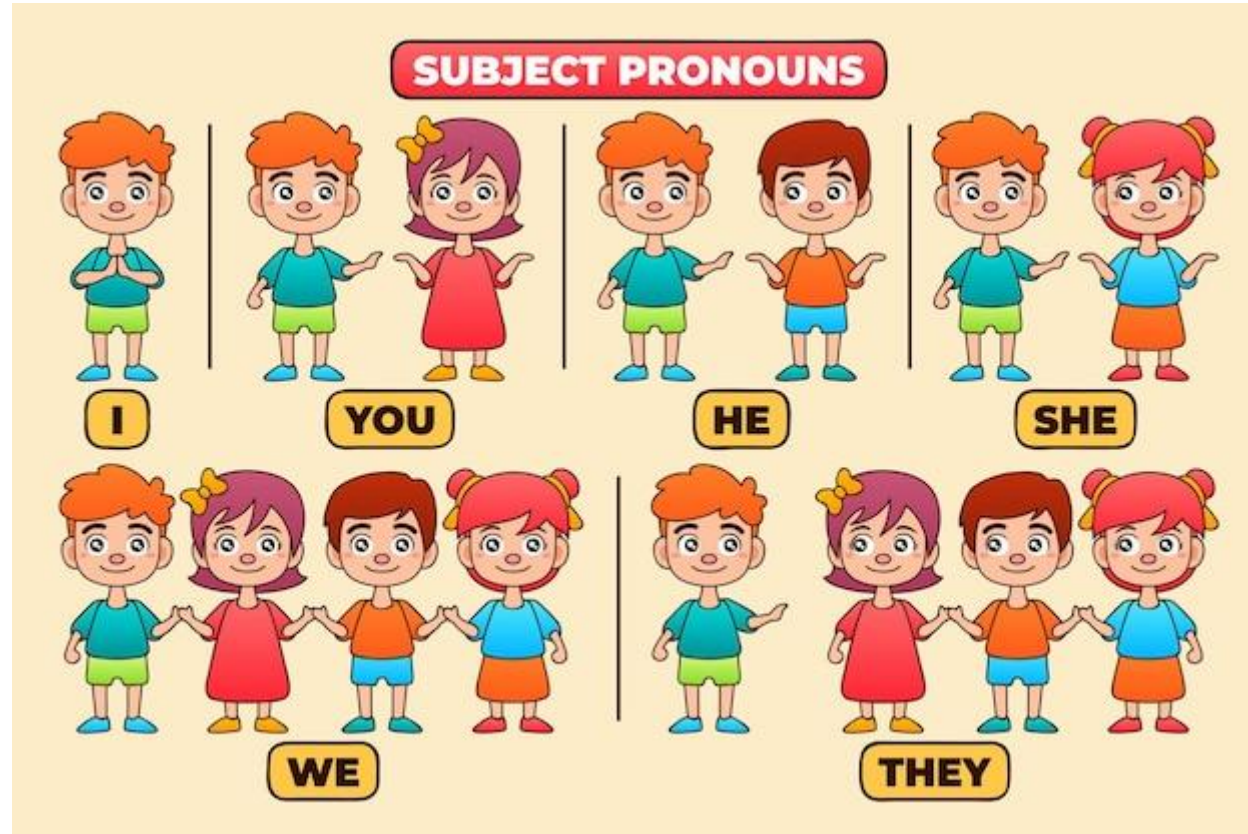

formula:

Subject + verb + complementet

ejemplo:

she + is + a teacher

ella es una maestra



► negative from

formula:

Subject + verb + not + complementet

ejemplo:

she + is + not + a teacher

ella no es una maestra



► interrogative from

formula:

Subject + verb + complementet + ?

ejemplo:

she + is + a teacher + ?

ella es una maestra ?

Short answers: yes, she is-----no, she is not

affirmative-----negative
