



SPELLING RULES

An -e at the end of the words is removed but -ee, oe, and -ye remain unchanged.

Example: come--- coming

But: agree – agreeing.

The final consonant is doubled in words that have a short stressed vowel before the final consonant. However, -W, - X and - Y are not doubled.

Example: sit- sitting

But: fix- fixing
