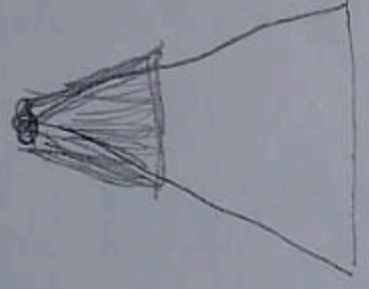

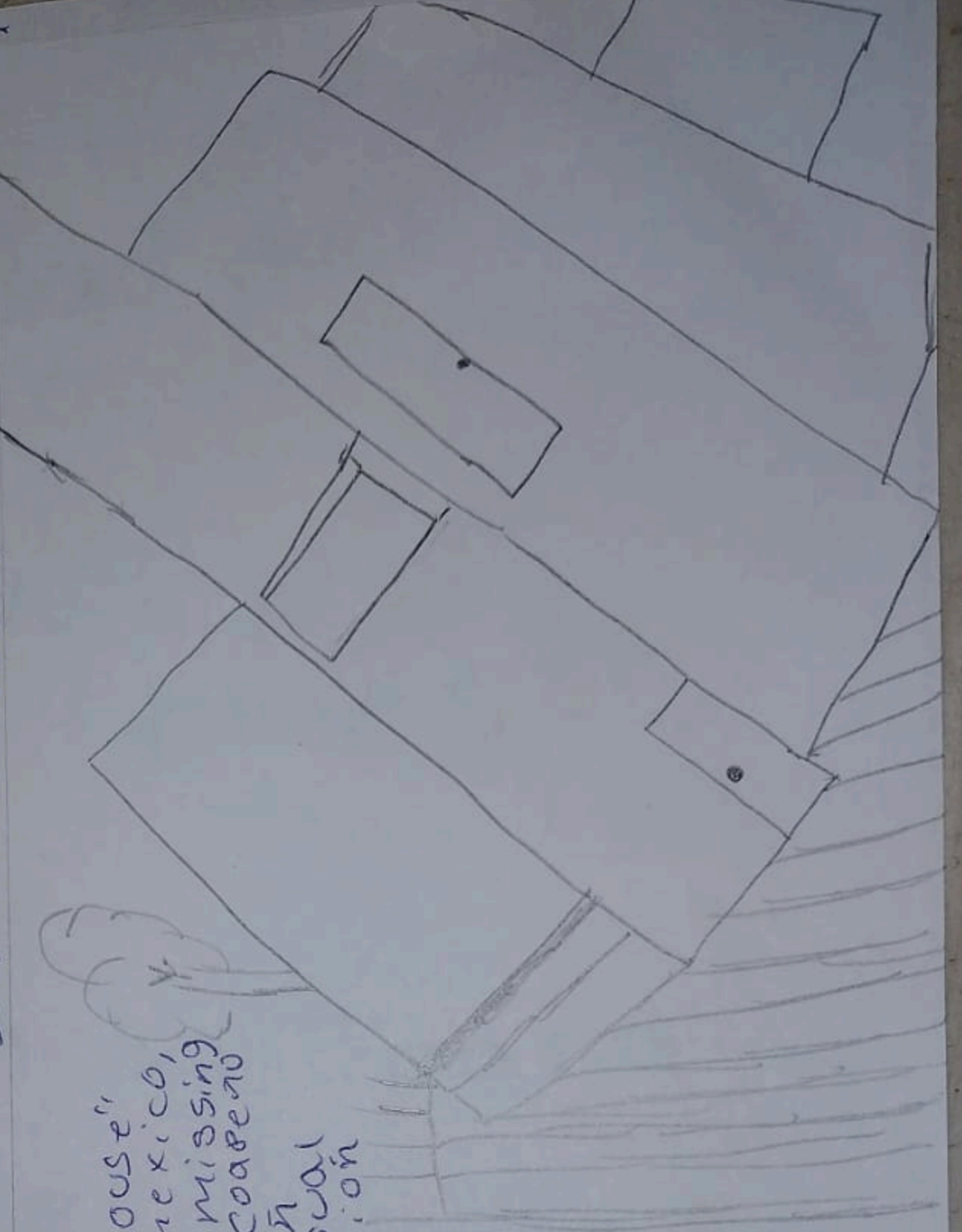


Chueca House

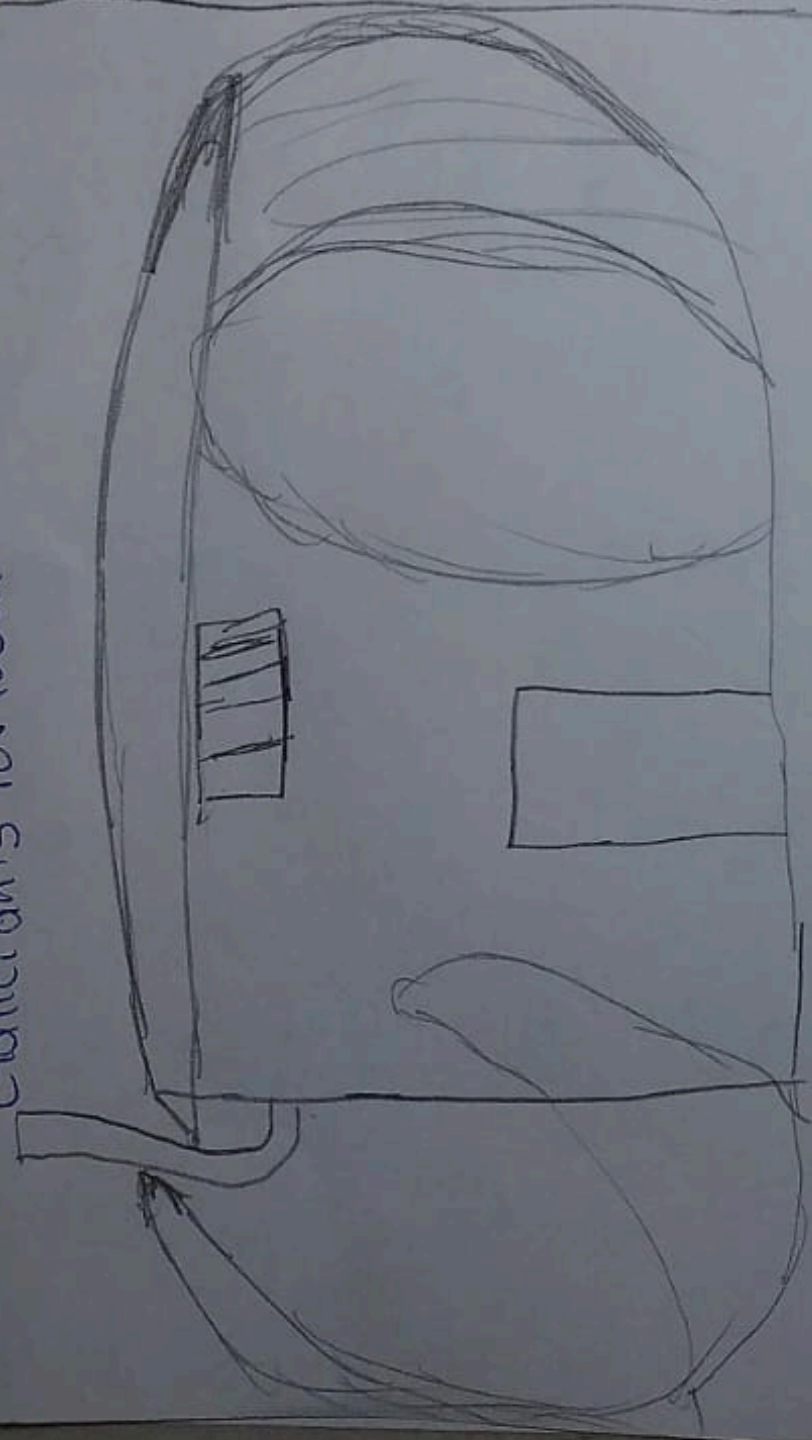
Uicla cooba, Mexico City.

"Joyxee" Pet House Isla Mujeres, Quintana Roo.

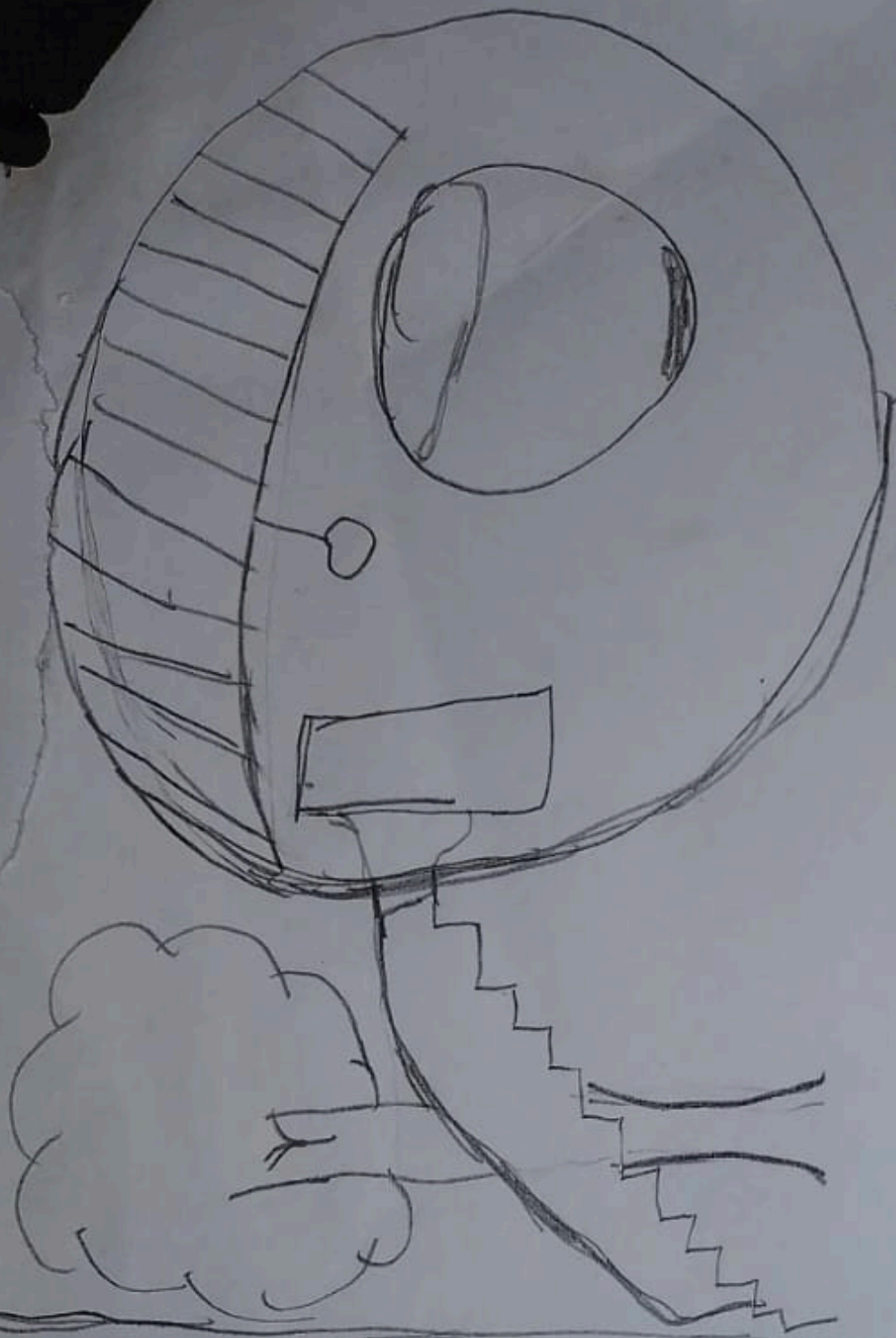

This striking private home, built in 1974, is located in the north of Portugal and surrounded by windmills. Drilled between four rocks, its construction took about two years and was intended to be a vacation retreat. It is made entirely of rock, except for the roof, door and windows. Few buildings are as integrated into the landscape as Casa do Penedo, and its interior is decorated in a rustic style with a lot of wood. This small but original stone house, which has three bedrooms and a bathroom, is not available to visit its interior, but even so, there are many tourists who come to the Serra de Gerês to see firsthand its spectacular exterior and take home a souvenir photo.



Spherical wooden houses in the trees or curious-world-houses they are made to be hung from trees or placed in the crowns of leafy trees thanks to a cable structure. They are accessed thanks to a spiral staircase and a small bridge as shown in the previous image. Pre Spirit Shores is a company that is in charge of building these curious houses that integrate perfectly among the trees, looking like another element of nature.
