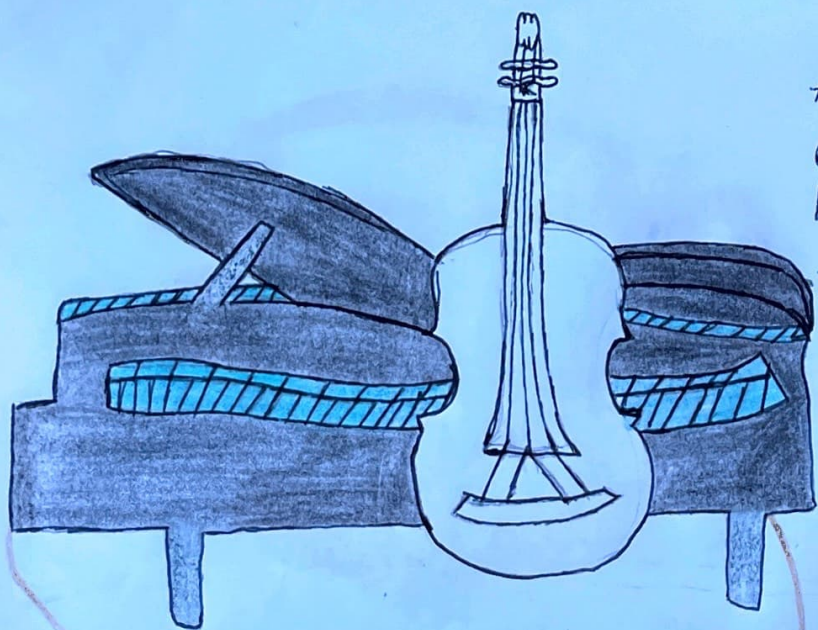


"Upside down house" In Trassenheide (Germany) It was built as a tourist attraction by polish architects Klaudiusz Golos and Sebastian

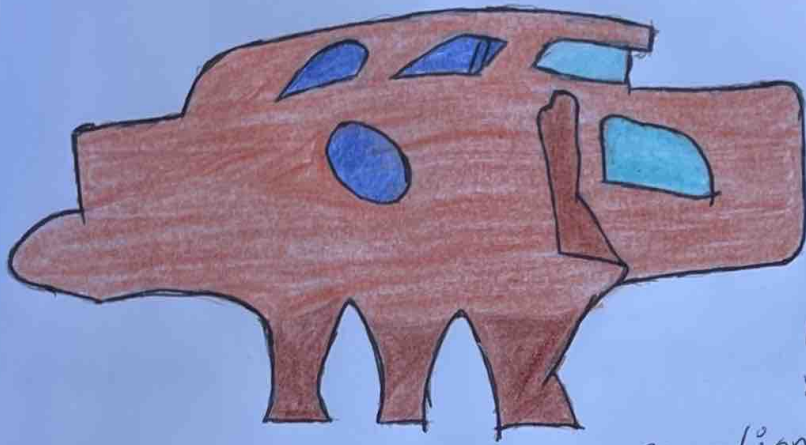
Mikiciuk as part of the "Upside down world" project. It allowed visitors to see the world from a different perspective. Everything in this use, including the furniture, is upside down.

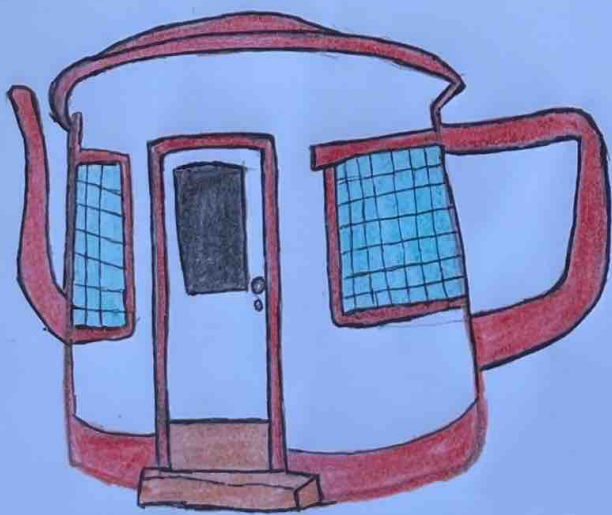

"The steel house"  
In the state of Texas,  
USA, is the house of  
Acero. The person

creation was the architect  
and sculptor Robert Bruno, who took no more and no less  
than 39 years to build this place, whose appearance gives the  
impression of being a giant pig. And it weighs 110 tons of steel. The  
architect only lived for 8 months after finishing it, since death overtook  
him after finishing his magnum opus. There are those who consider this  
house a true work of art, and for this reason it is regularly visited  
by tourist from all over the world.

1992, the Teapot House was  
built in Washington, USA. This  
Teapot Home was built as a  
reminder of the incidents  
of corruption around  
President Warren G. Harding,  
related to the Wyoming oil  
reserver, and which were  
called "The Teapot Dome

House also serves as a service station.
