Affirmative

Subject + Verb + Complement

When the verb ends in, O, SA, CH, X, SS
When the verb end in "Y" we eliminate the "Y" and add (ES)
In the third person singular "He, she, It" a "S".

Negative

Subject + Assistant Do / Does + Verb + complement

In the pronous "I, You" the auxiliary verb "Do" is added followed by the particle "Do not". Although for (He, She, It) the form "Does" ("Does not").

Interrogative

Assistant + Does + Subject + Verb + complement + ?

In interrogative sentences the auxiliary verb "Do, Does" is placed at the beginning of the sentence followed by the subject, the main verb and in some cases a complement.

You	run
He	runs
She	runs
It	runs
They	run

He	doesn't student
She	doesn't student
It	doesn't student
They	don't student

Does	He fly a plane?
