# When to use? !!

We use the past simple tense to talk

## Examples !!

- Completed action: I visited Barcelona last year.
- Specific time: She met her friends at 8 PM yesterday.
- Sequence of events: He woke up, got dressed, and went out.

## How to use? !!

Positive structure!!!  
All the subjects take the past form (V1) of the verb.

Examples: Subject + I  
Pronoun  
\*The ate lunch an hour ago.  
\*My mum went to Istanbul night.

Negative structure!!!  
All the subjects take didn't on the base form (V1) of the verb.

Examples: Subject + didn't + V1  
Pronoun  
\*The didn't study math yesterday  
\*I didn't go to school last week.

Actions that occurred at a specific time in the past

Question structure!!!  
We use did before the subject, the verb is in base form (V1)

Did + subject + V1  
Pronoun

## Examples:-

- \*Did you read a book yesterday?
- \*Did he go to bed late last night?

Irregular verbs - Irregular verbs form their past forms by adding -d, -ed, -icd to the base form.

## Irregular verbs:

- \*Irregular verbs do not follow a consistent pattern for their past forms.
- \*Each irregular verb has a unique past form!

## IRREGULAR VERBS

Question structure we use did before subject, the verb base form (V1)

Did + subject + V1  
Pronoun

## How to use? !!

• Positive structure!!!  
All the subjects take the past form (V2) of the verb.

### Examples:-

Subject + V2  
Pronoun

- \* He ate lunch an hour ago.
- \* My mum went to Istanbul night.

## Negative structure!!!

All the subjects take didn't on the base form (V1) of the verb.

Subject + didn't + V1  
Pronoun

### Examples:-

- \* He didn't study math yesterday.
- \* I didn't go to school last week.
