The present perfect is used to describe an action or situation that started in the past and continues in the present.

Note!
3rd @ we used / for questions and negative answers we used does or doesn't
-s, -es, -es
or -1-

Positive

Subject + Verbo + Complemento
I drink too much coffee
She drinks too much coffee



Negative

Subject + do/does not + verbo
I do not kiss her last night
He doesn't kiss her last night



Interrogative

do/does + Subject + verbo + Complemento
Do I dance last night?
Does he dance last night?
