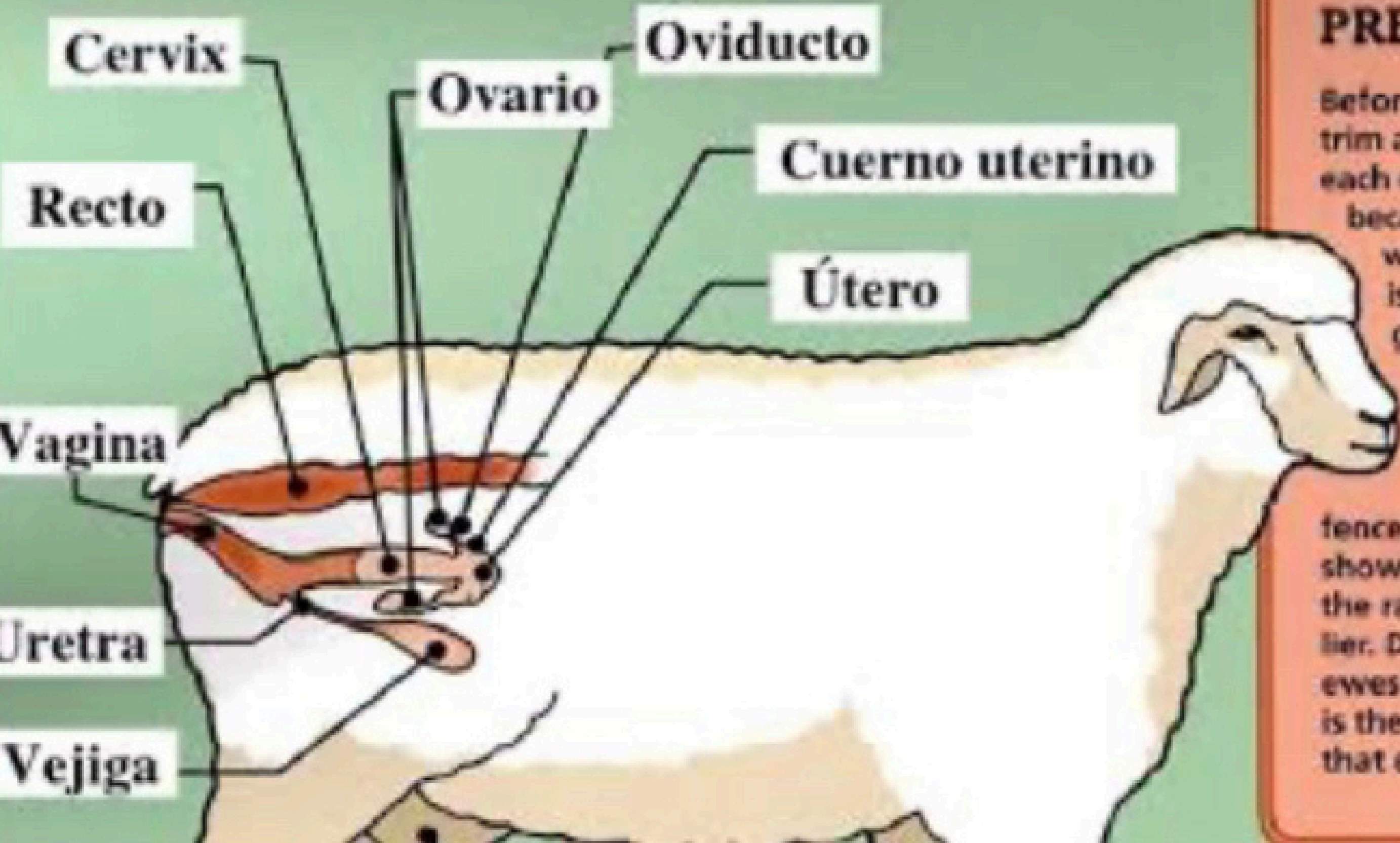

## PREPARING THE EWES

Before the breeding season begins, trim away any wool tags from around each ewe's tail and trim her feet, because she will be carrying extra weight during pregnancy and it is important for her feet to be in good condition.

Seventeen days before you would like to start breeding, put your ram in a pasture adjacent to the ewes with a solid fence separating them. Research has shown that the sound and scent of the ram bring the ewes into heat earlier. Don't pen the ram next to the ewes before this sensitizing period. It is the sudden contact with the rams that excites the females.
