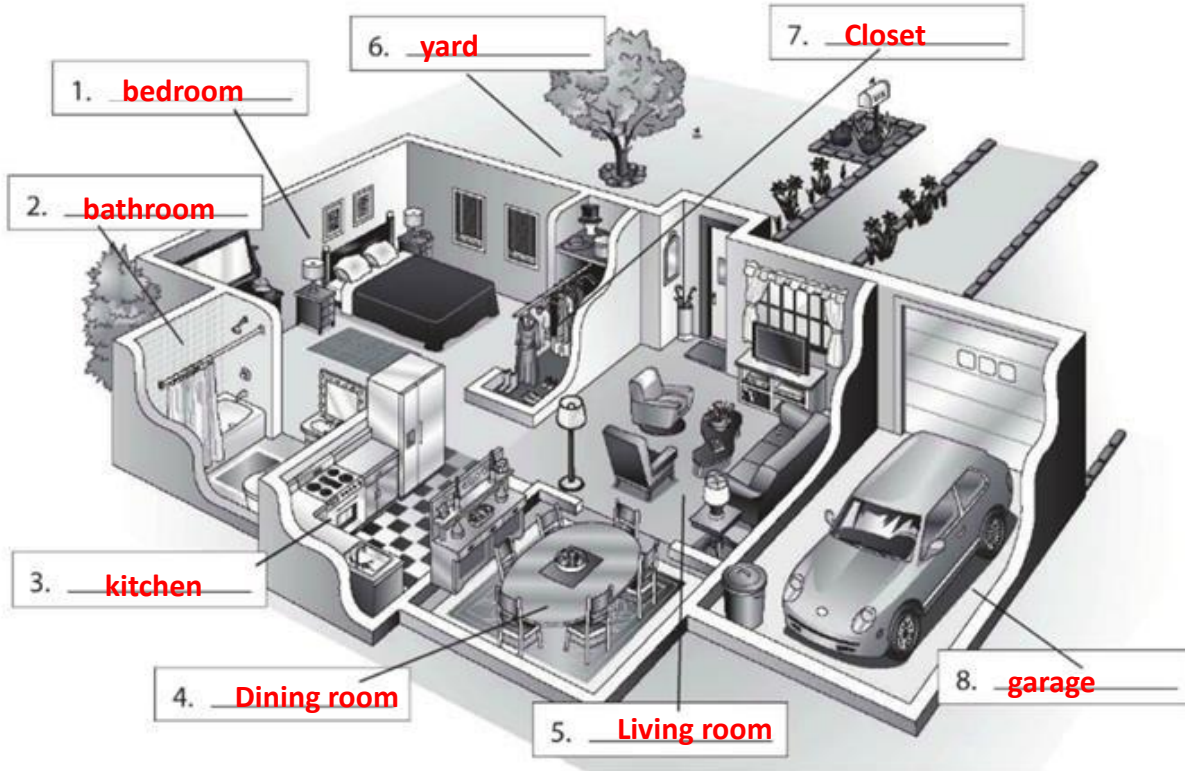

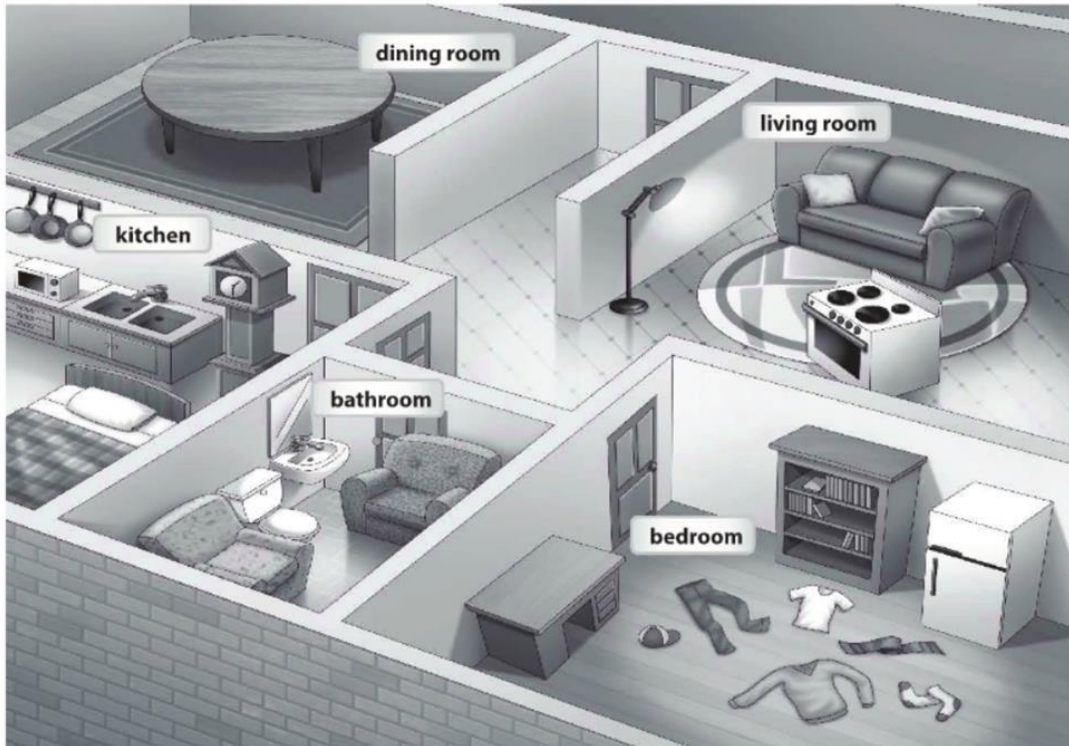

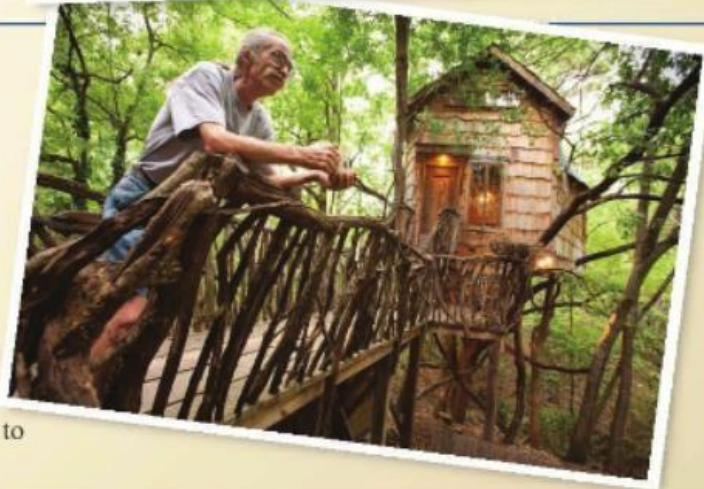
Unusual Homes
