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# SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

Express habits and routines, general facts, repeated actions or situations.

## STRUCTURE:

Affirmative:

Subject + Verbo + Complemento

Example:

- I drink coffee every morning.
- She speaks French fluently.



Negative:

Subject + Auxiliary Do/Does not / Verbo + Complemento

Example:

- I don't drink coffee every morning.
- She doesn't speak French fluently.



Interrogative:

Auxiliary do/does + subject + verbo + Complemento + ?

Example:

- Do you drink coffee every morning?
- Does she speak French fluently?



## RULES:

1. In the third person singular, the verb always ends in -s.

3. For the negative and interrogative forms, we use 'Do' the infinitive of the verbs.

2. When verbs end in: a, sh, ch, ss, x, z you must add "es" to the end.

4. Verbs ending in "y" in the third person singular, the y is changed to: "ies".
