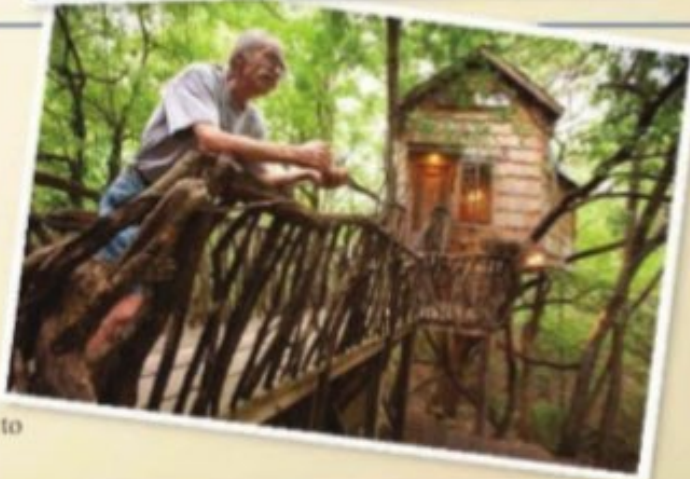
Unusual Homes
