

AF in verb to-be



Affirmative Subject + verb to be + adverb of frequency + complement

Susan is always happy.

Negative Subject + verb to be not + adverb of frequency + complement

Nick is not usually in Mexico.

Interrogative Verb to be + subject + adverb of frequency + complement?

Is Peter usually sick?

AF in present simple

Affirmative Subject + adverb of frequency + verb + complement

They often meet friends and have a drink together

Negative Subject + don't doesn't + adverb of frequency + verb + complement

Sara doesn't always go out on Saturday evenings.

Interrogative Do Does + Subject + adverb of frequency + verb + complement?


