Affirmative subject + verb to be + adverb of frequency + complement

Susan is always happy.

Negative	subject + verb to be + not + adverb of frequency + complement			
Nick is not usually in México.				

Interrogative verb to be + subject +adverb of frequency + complement?

Is Peter usually sick?



AF in present simple

Affirmative Subject + adverb of frequency + verb + complement

They often meet friends and have a drink together.

Negative Subject + don't / doesn't + adverb of frequency + verb + complement

Sara doesn't always go out on Saturday evenings.

Interrogative Do/ Does + subject + adverb of frequency + verb + complemet?

Does she usually call her mother?
