

There SOME fruit in the kitchen.	There aren't ANY mosquitoes.
I have SOME cousins who live in pichucalco.	Interrogative ❖ Is there ANY coin the shelf?
	Do you have ANY close relatives?

SOME/ANY

We use some and any like this:

- a. For a question, we use 'any'
- b. For a positive answer, we use 'some'
- c. For a negative answer, we use 'any'

Do you have **any** money?

- Yes, I have some money.
- No, I don't have any money.


Do you play any sports?

- Yes, I play some sports.
- No, I don't play any sports.

Are there **any** students in the classroom?

- ❖ Yes, there are **some** students in the classroom
- No, there aren't **any** students in the classroom.

Sometimes I exercise.


I never sleep late.


