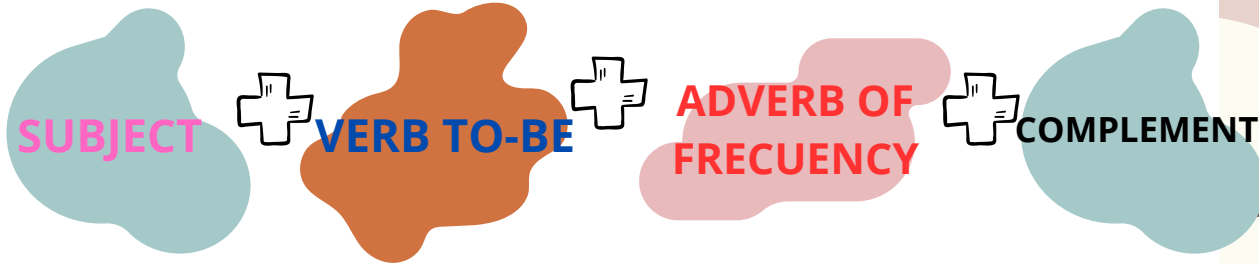

- ✅ They hardly ever go to the library.

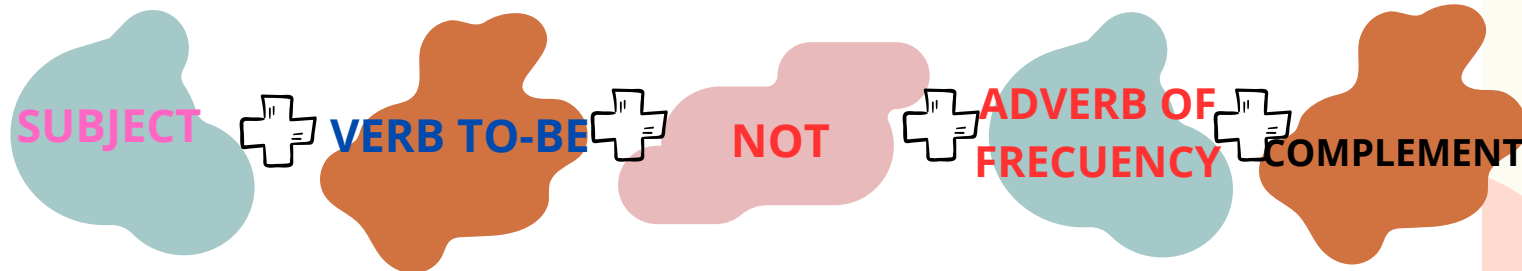

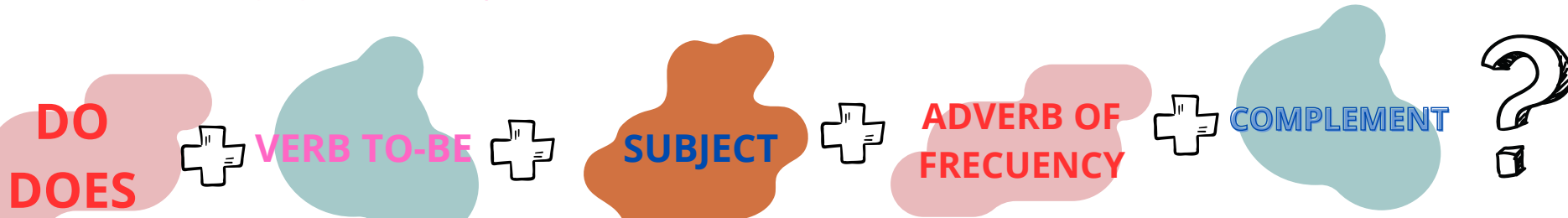
