	Afirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I you we they	eat	don't eat	Do...eat?
he she it	eats	doesn't eat	Does...eat?

Examples:

### Affirmative

- He eat fried food.
- She eats sweets

### Negative

- I don't eat hot dogs.
- You doesn't eat tortilla.

### Interrogative

- Do you like eat pizza?
- Does she east papa fried?

Interrogative form

**Do/does** are auxiliaries used to make interrogative sentences.

Do	I you we they	Drink?
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Does	He She it	Drink?

# There is/ There are

INTERROGATIVE

**IS THERE...?**

- **Is there** a cinema in Pichucalco?

**ARE THERE...?**

- **Are there** any restaurants in Pichucalco?

NEGATIVE

**THERE ISN'T** (there's no)

- **There isn't** an apple on the table.

**THERE AREN'T** (there are no)

- **There aren't** any apples on the table.

AFFIRMATIVE

**THERE IS**

- **There is** a fridge in his house.

**THERE ARE**

- **There are** some fridges in Coppel.

## Examples:

### Afirmative:

- There is one spoon in the table.
- There are three cat at the garage.

### Negative:

- There isn't enough apples on the table.
- There aren't enough food for the three of them.

### Interrogative:

- is there un circo en tapilula?.
- Are there a taxi at the stop?
