Does she need **any** wine? (uncountable)  
¿ Necesita vino?

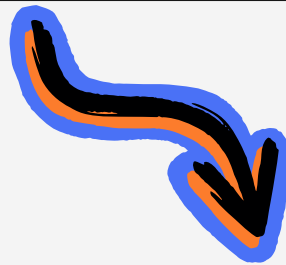
Adverbs of frequency.
