4. we didn´t buy **any** apples at the market.

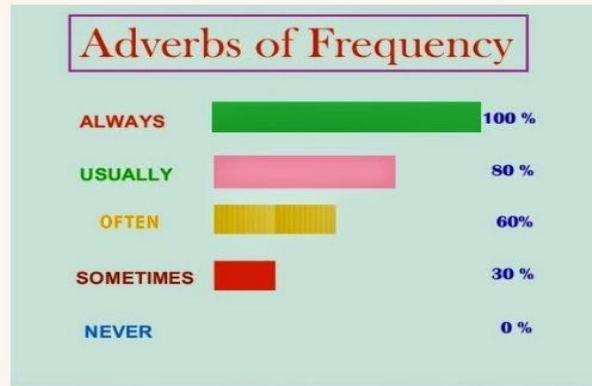

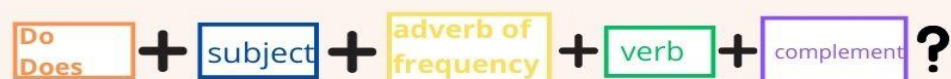
