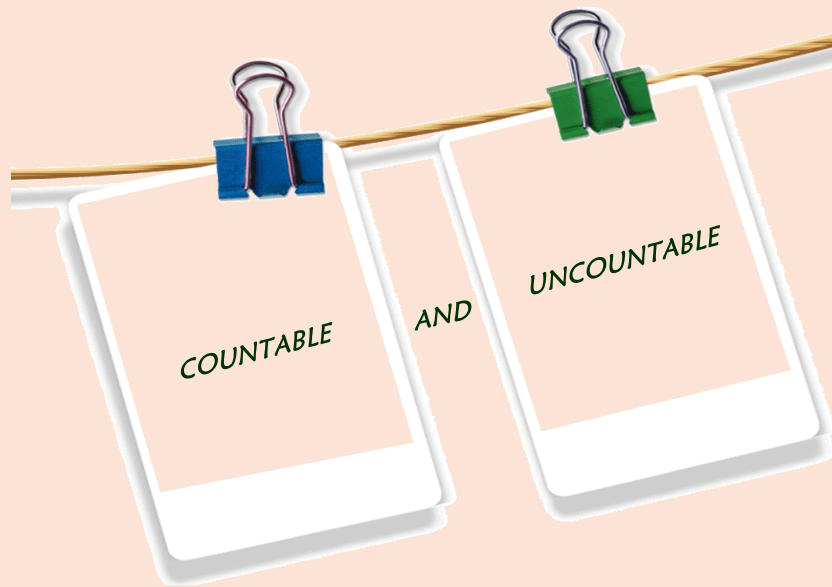

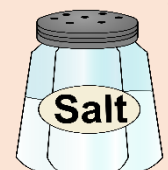

DO YOU HAVE A BROTHER **CS**



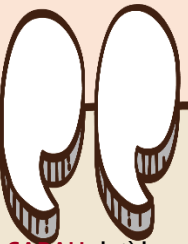
### USE "SOME" OR "ANY"

**KUMIKO:** ok. Come to my house . my family always has a japanese- style breakfast on Sundays.

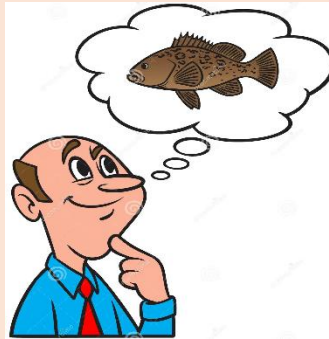
**ARAH:** really? What do you have?

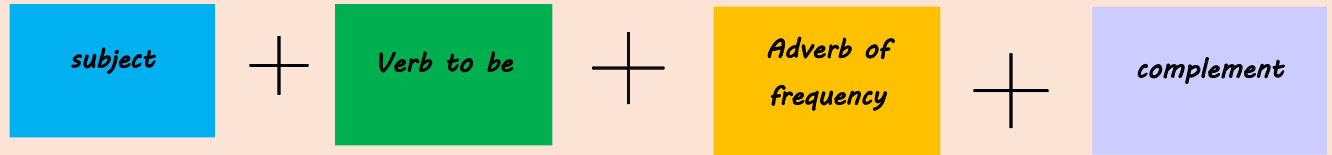

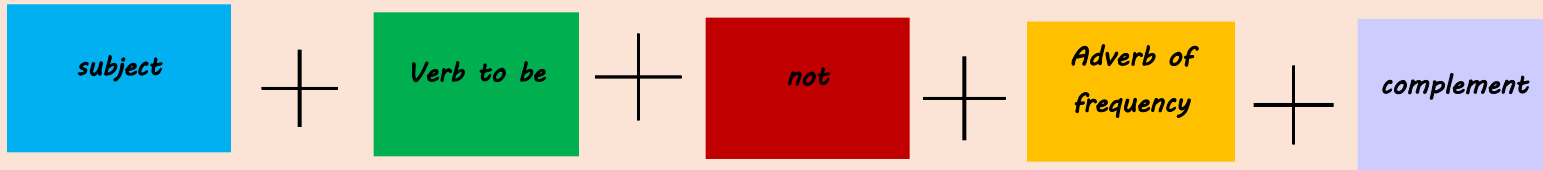

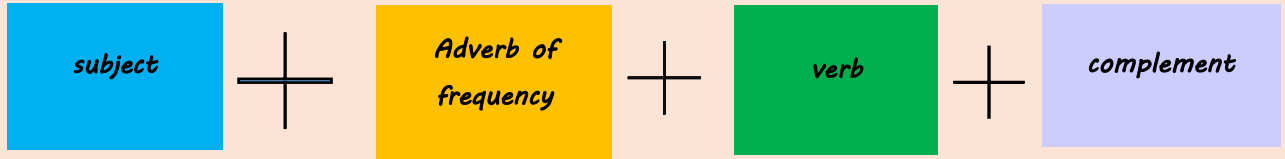
