**KUMIKO:** Ok. Come to my house. My family always has Japanese – style breakfast on Sundays.

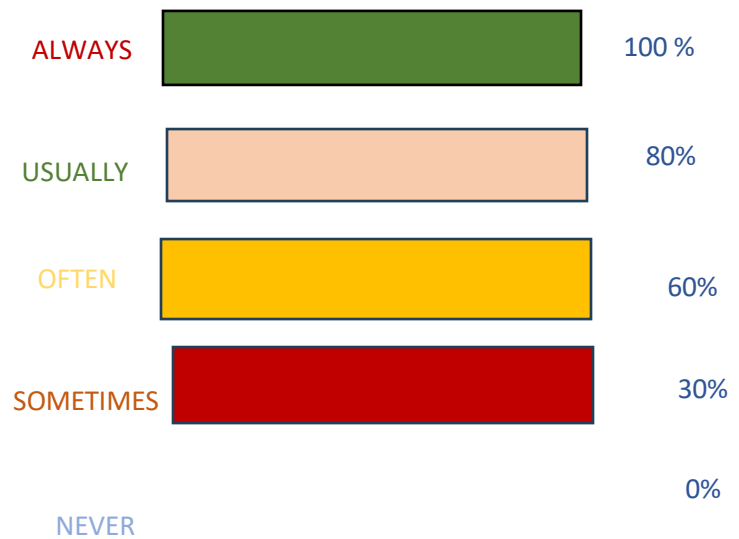
