3. There isn't a chair. C P

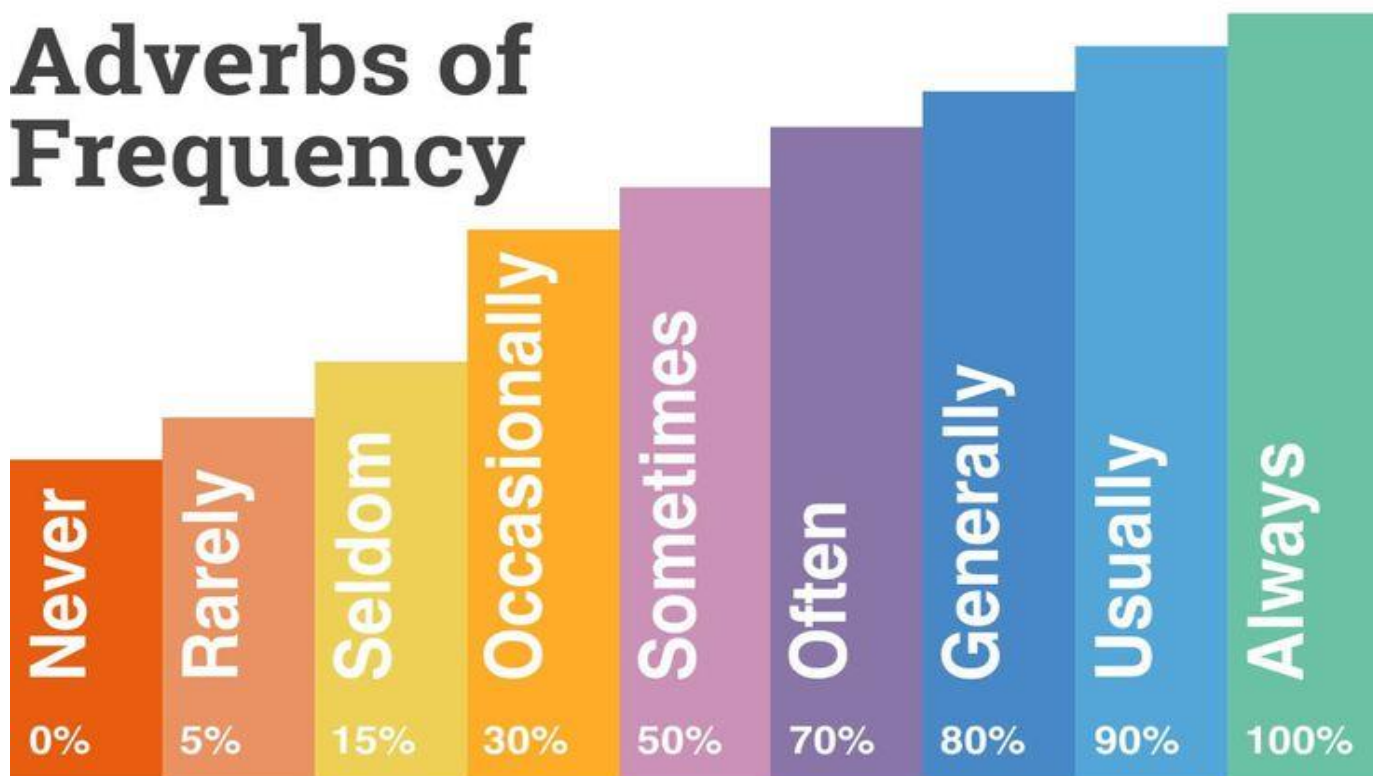
INTERROGATIVE

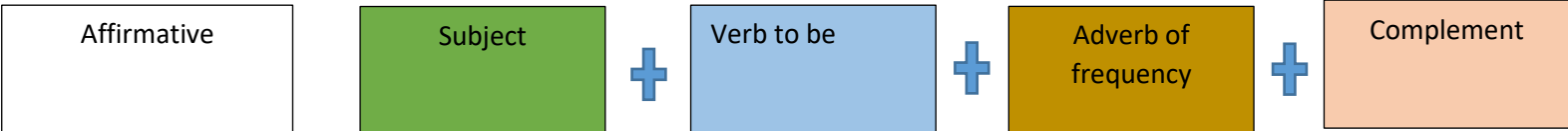

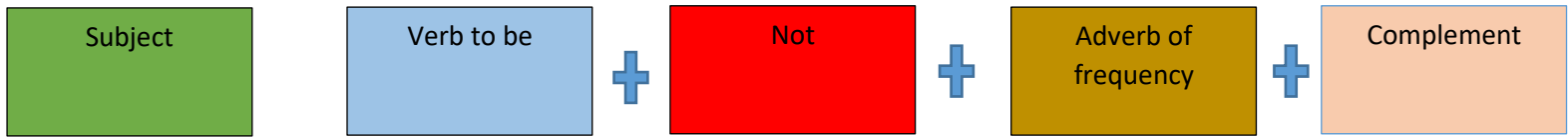

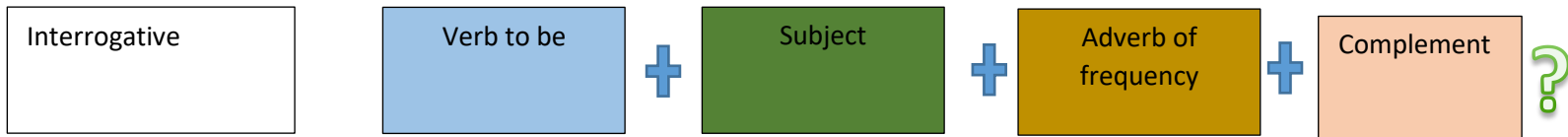


Susan is always happy

Negative

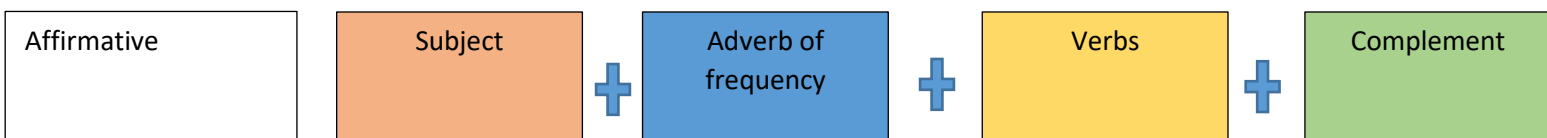


Nick is not usually in Mexico.



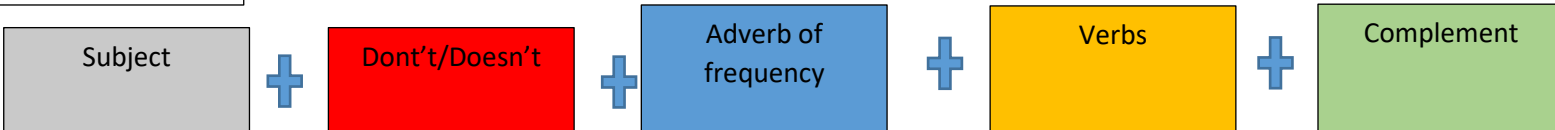
Is peter usually sick?

Af in present simple



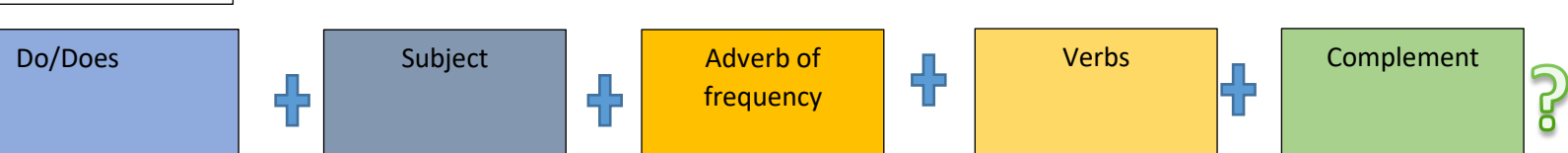
They often meet Friends and have a drink together.
