<b>50</b> %	SOMETIMES	Sometimes, I just need someone to talk to.
30%	OCCASIONALLY	We occasionally meet for a drink after work.
15%	SELDOM	I have <mark>seldom</mark> seen such brutality.
5%	RARELY	She is old and rarely goes out.

  - I can swim.
- 2. permission
  - You can use my pen.
