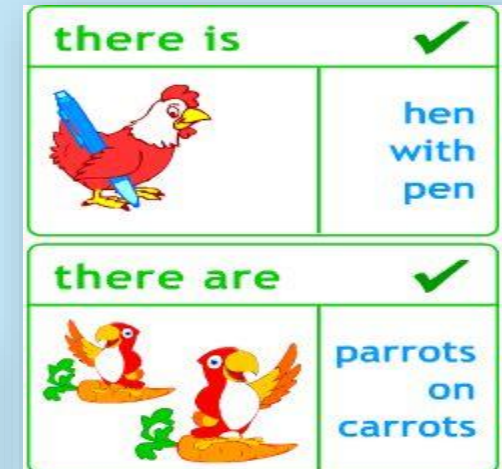
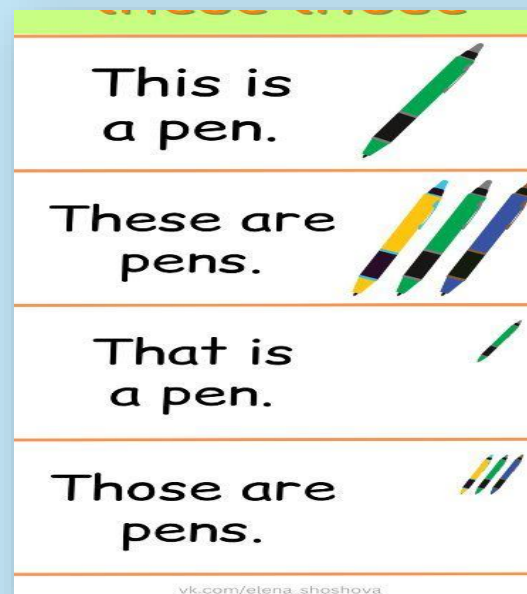
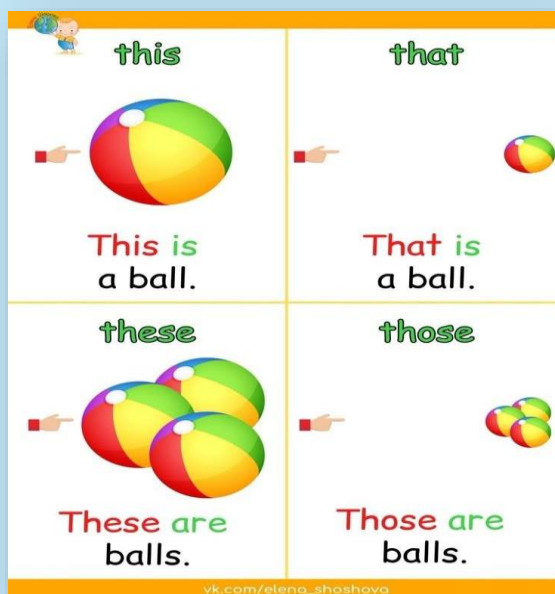
An apartment can have the same things as a house but it is much smaller



"There is" AND "there are"

"There is" is used to refer to the singular, while "there are" is used to refer to the plural. Both expressions are used in English to indicate the presence of something or someone in a place.

- "There is a woman in the park" (Hay una mujer en el parque)
- "There are two women in a café" (Hay dos mujeres en una cafetería)
- "There is an apple on the table" (Hay una manzana sobre la mesa)
- "There is one chair in the room" (Hay una silla en la habitación)









Wh.questions with present simple

"Wh" questions in the simple present tense are informative questions that begin with words beginning with "wh."
These words include: who, what, when, where, why, how, how many, how much.

EJEMPLO:

- What does she do ----- Qué hace ella
- How do I arrive ----- como llego
- When does he go to work ---- ¿Cuándo va a trabajar?
- Why does it rain so much here ----- ¿Por qué llueve tanto aquí?
- Who do we need to talk to. ----- ¿Con quién necesitamos hablar?

WHEN is a time 	WHERE is a place 
HOW is the way something is or the way sth happens 	WHY is the reason 



Who is a person 	What is a thing or action 
When is a time 	Where is a place 



Jobs and workplaces:

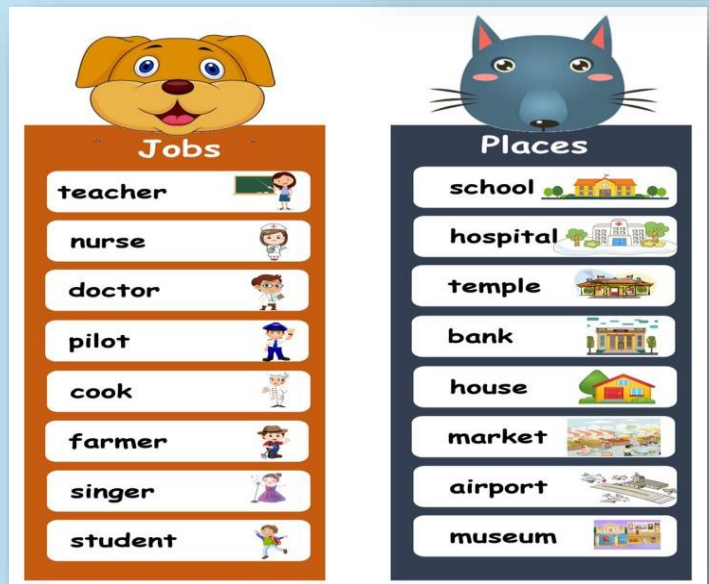
"Job" is used to refer to a specific position in a company, while "work" refers to a general activity or task.
