DO WE HAVE THERE BOOKS?

SHORT ANSWERS

AFIRMATIVE

- YES, I DO
- YES, HE DOES

NEGATIVE

- NO, I DON'T
- NO, SHE DOESN'T

THERE IS / THERE ARE

"AFIRMATIVE"

- There is
 - There is a fridge in his house
- There are
 - There are some fridges in coppel

"NEGATIVE"

- There isn't (there's no)
 - There isn't an apple on the table.
- There aren't (There are no)
 - There aren't any apples on the tables.

"INTERROGATIVE"

- Is there...?
 - Is there a cinema in pichucalco?
- Are there...?
 - Are there any restaurants in pichucalco?
